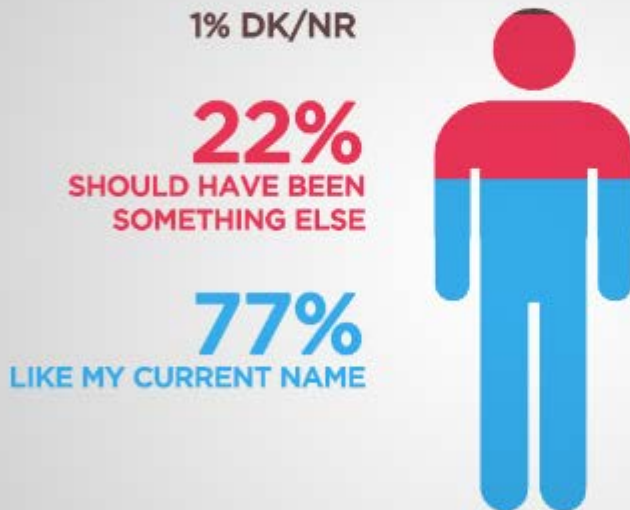

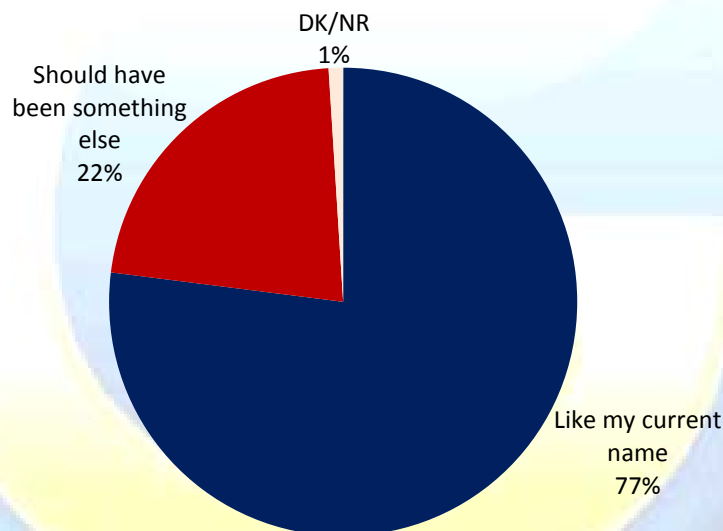
Significant majority (77 %) of Pakistanis are fond of their name. (GRF POLL)

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, significant majority (77%) of Pakistanis like their name.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, "Some people are very fond of their name, while some are not and wish that their name had been different. Please tell if you are fond of your name or you wish that it had been different?" In response to this question, 77% respondents said that they liked their current name, while 22% respondents said that they wished their name was something else. 1% did not know or did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1788 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during May 16 - May 23, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
