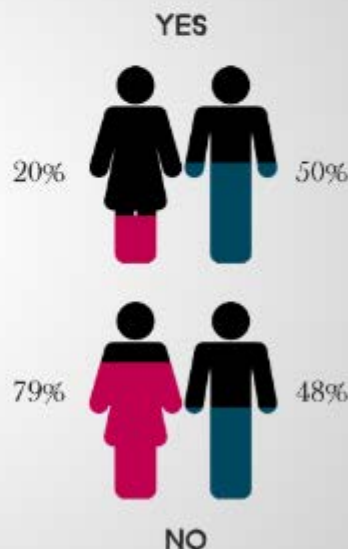
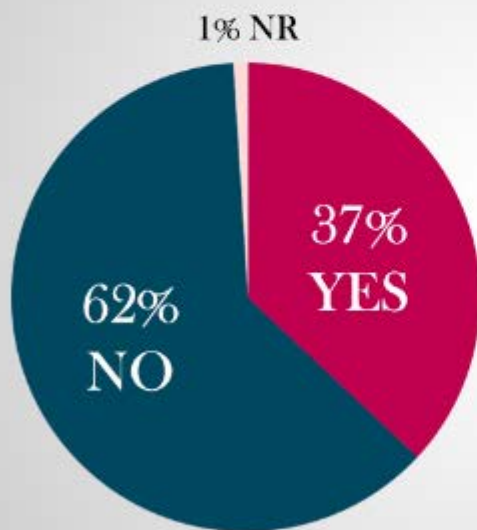

Majority (62 %) Pakistanis have not attended a funeral in the past two months; significant majority (79 %) of women has not attended a funeral in the past two months. (GRF POLL)

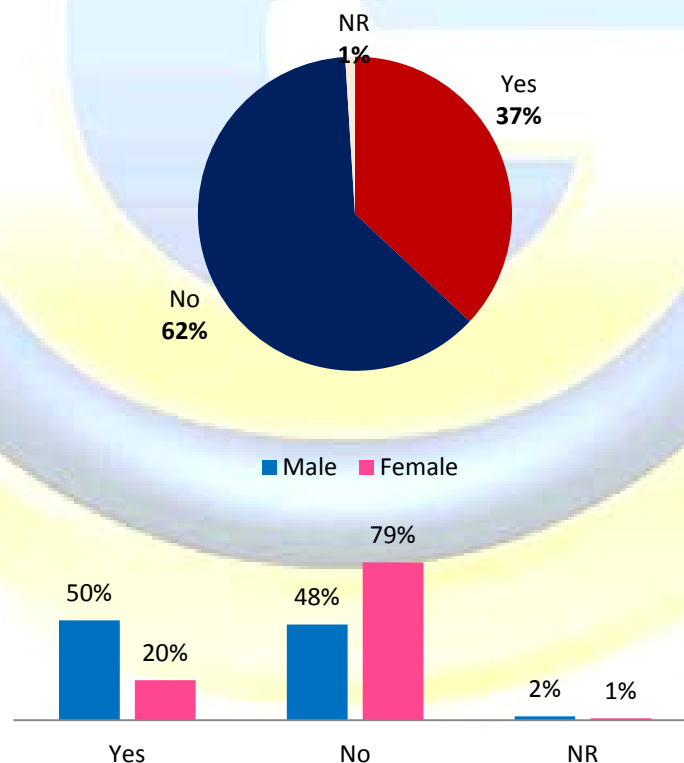

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, majority (62%) Pakistanis have not attended a funeral in the past two months. More men than women have attended funerals in the past two months.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, "Did you attend any funeral in the past two months?" In response to this question, 37% respondents said that yes, they had attended a funeral in the past two months, while 62% respondents said that no, they had not attended a funeral in the past two months. 1% did not respond.

According to a gender breakdown, there is a significant difference between the number of men and women who attend funerals. It seems that more men than women tend to attend funerals. Only 20% females said that they had attended a funeral in the past two months, while 50% men said that they had attended a funeral in the past two months. 79% females and 48% said that they had not attended a funeral in the past two months. 2% men and 1% women did not respond to the question.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1788 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during May 16 - May 23, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
