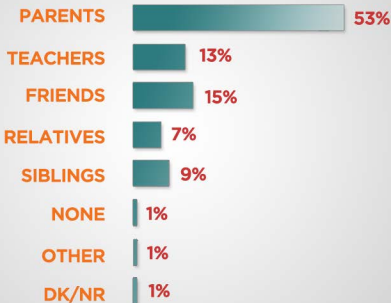


MAJORITY PAKISTANIS (53%) CLAIM TO BE MOST INSPIRED BY THEIR PARENTS.

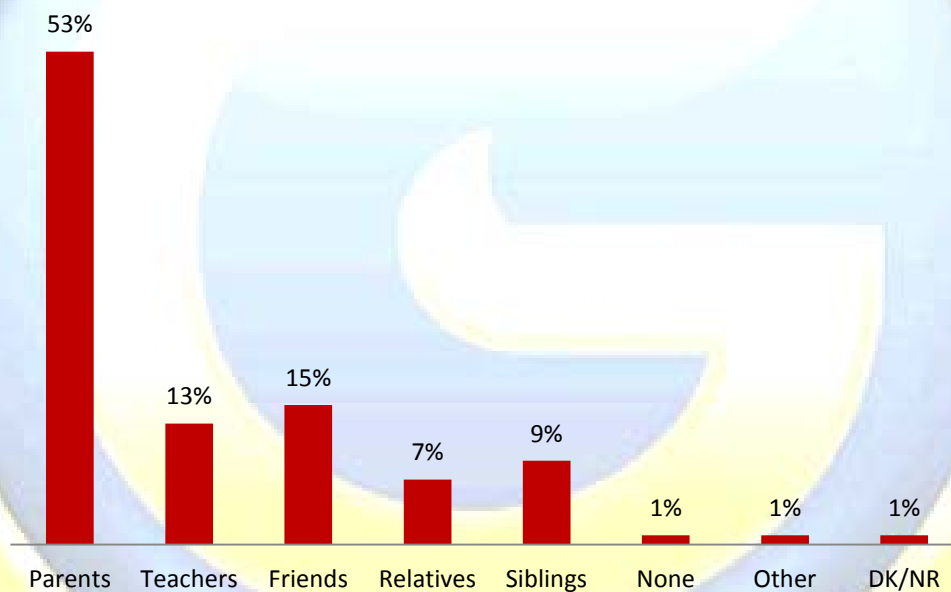
**Majority Pakistanis (53%) claim to be most inspired by their parents.

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 53% Pakistanis claim to be most inspired by their parents.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Who are you most inspired from in your life? (Please choose one option only)” In response to this question, 53% respondents said that they are most inspired by their parents, 13% said that they are most inspired by their teachers, 15% said friends, 7% said relatives, 9% said siblings, 1% said none, and 1% said other. Another 1% did not know or did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1830 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during June 06 – June 13, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
