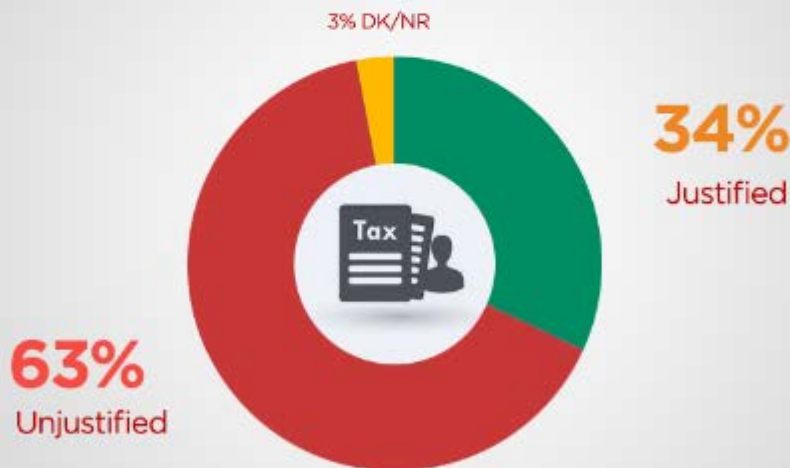

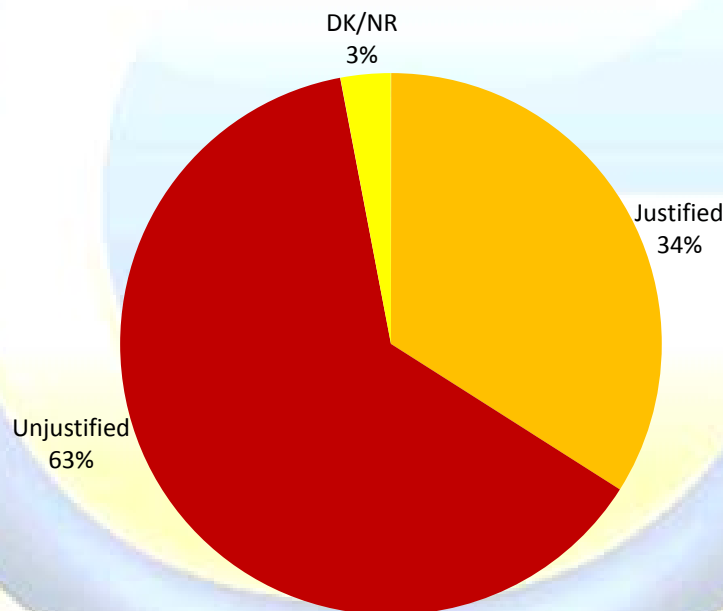
63% Pakistanis are of the opinion that taxes that the government imposes are unjustified. (GRF POLL)

Islamabad, August 11, 2016

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, majority Pakistanis (63%) are of the opinion that all the taxes the government imposes are unjustified.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, "Some people are of the opinion that all the taxes that the government imposes are entirely justified, whereas some people deem them unjustified. In your opinion, are these taxes justified or unjustified?" In response to this question, 34% said that all the taxes levied by the government are entirely justified, while 63% deemed them unjustified. 3% did not know, or did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1830 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during June 06 – June 13, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
