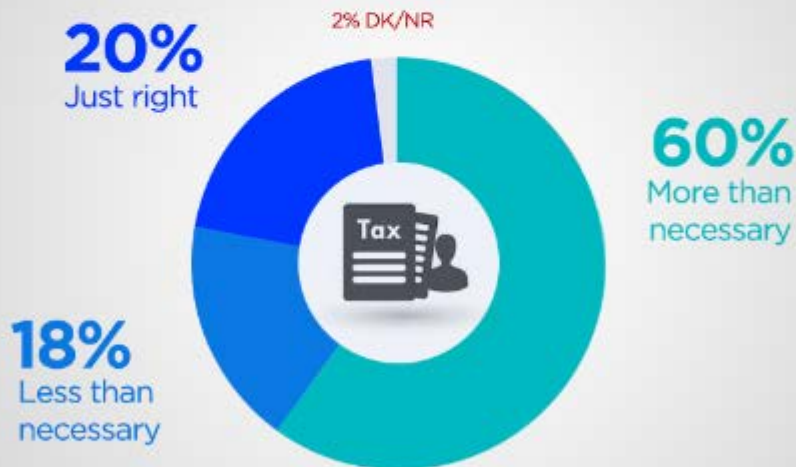


60% PAKISTANIS THINK THAT TAXES IN OUR COUNTRY ARE MORE THAN NECESSARY.

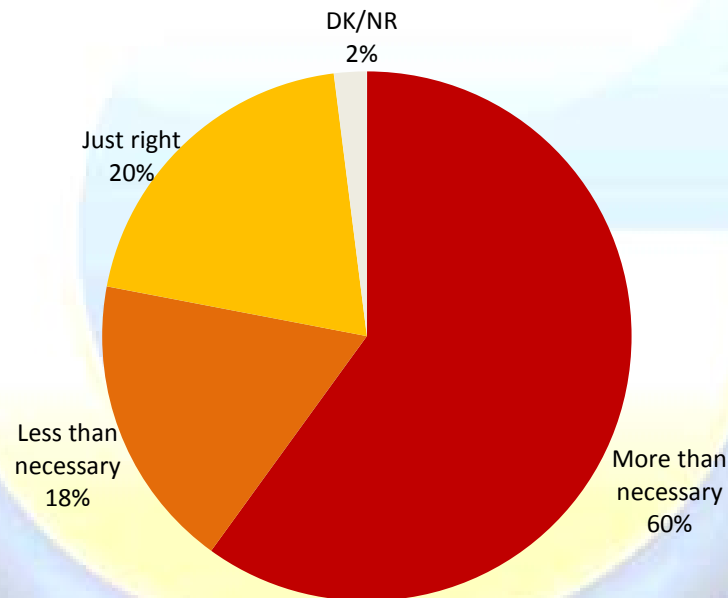
**60 % Pakistanis think that taxes in our country are more than necessary.

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, majority Pakistanis (60%) think that taxes in our country are more than necessary.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “In your opinion, the number of taxes in our country is more than necessary, less than necessary, or just right?” In response to this question, 60% said that the taxes were more than necessary, 18% said that they were less than necessary, and 20% said that they were just right. 2% did not know, or did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1830 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during June 06 – June 13, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
