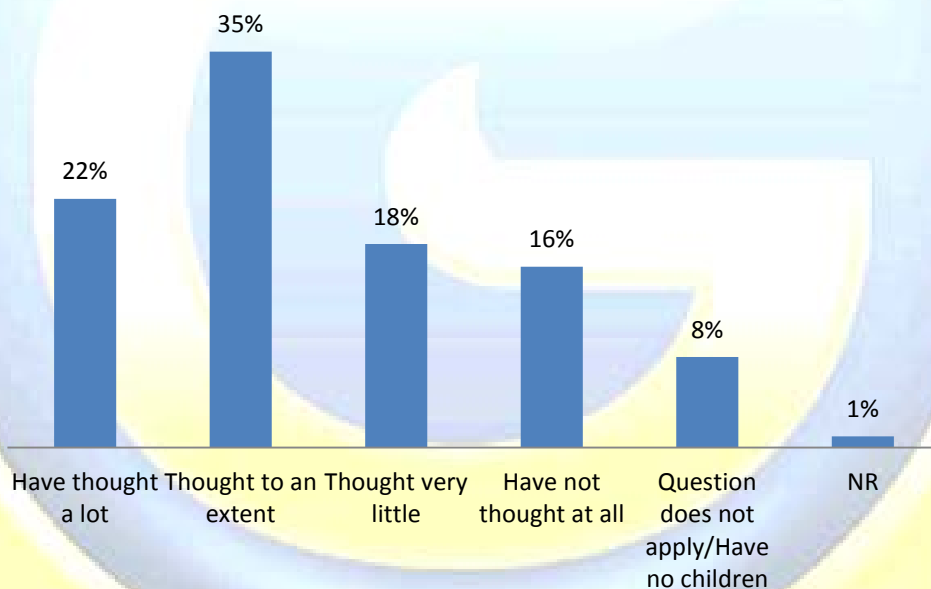
Majority (57%) Pakistani parents claim to have thought or planned about the academic future of their children. (GRF POLL)

Islamabad, September 19, 2016

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, majority (57%) Pakistani parents claim to have thought or planned about the academic future of their children.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, "Please tell, to what extent have you thought or planned about your children's academic future?" In response to this question, 22% said that they have thought about it a lot, 35% said that they have thought to an extent, 18% said that they have thought very little about it, 16% said that they have not thought about it at all, while 8% said that the question did not apply to them or they do not have any children. 1% did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1788 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during June 27 – July 04, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
