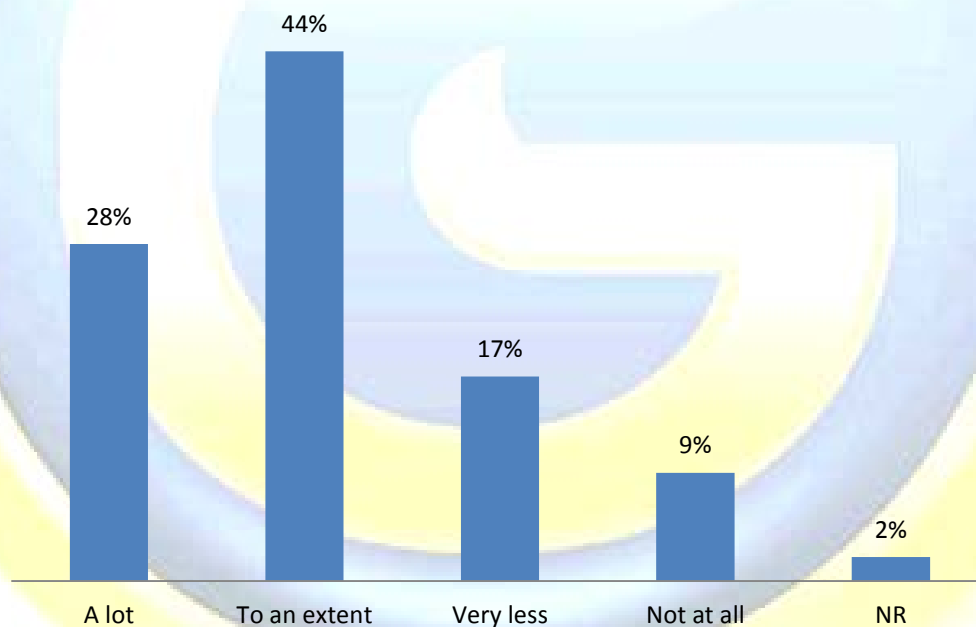
**Significant majority (72%) Pakistani parents claim to consult their children when deciding on their academic future. (GRF POLL)**

Islamabad, September 20, 2016

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, significant majority (72%) Pakistani parents claim to consult their children when deciding on their academic future.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, "Please tell, when considering your children's academic future, how much did you consult your children about it?" In response to this question, 28% said that they have consulted with their children a lot, 44% said that they have consulted to an extent, 17% said that they consulted them very less, while 9% said that they have not consulted them at all. 2% did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1788 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during June 27 – July 04, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2-3$  per cent at 95% confidence level.
