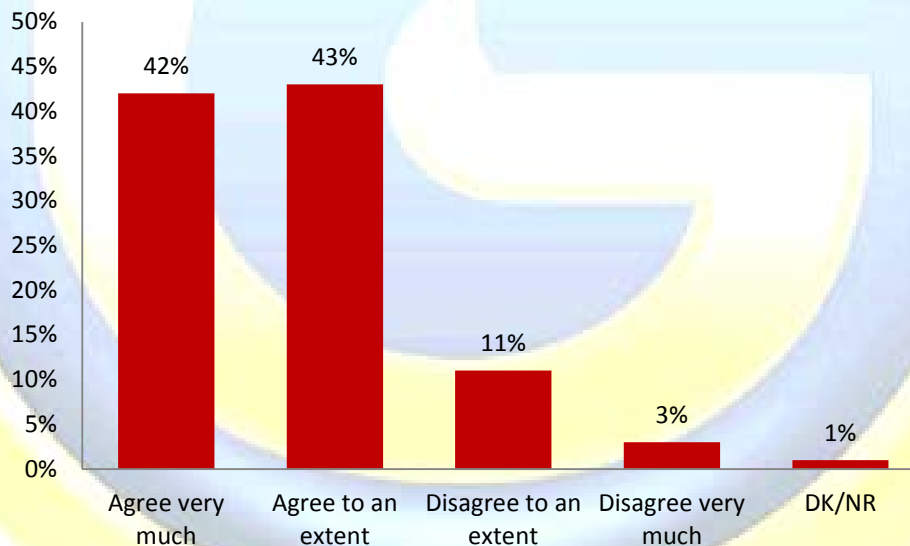
**A significant majority (85 %) of Pakistanis agree with the statement that their neighbors/villagers think of them as their son/daughter and are proud of their life's achievement. (GRF POLL)**

Islamabad, September 23, 2016

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, a significant majority (85%) of Pakistanis agree with the statement that their neighbors/villagers think of them as their son/daughter and are proud of their life's achievement.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, "Please tell if you agree or disagree with the following statement: 'My villagers/neighbors think of me as their son/daughter and are proud of my life's achievements.'" In response to this question, 42% said that they agree very much with the statement, 43% said that they agree to an extent, 11% said that they disagree to an extent, and 3% said that they disagree very much. 1% did not know or did not wish to respond. This is significant because it draws a circle around the society of people an average Pakistani takes into account when planning or making important decision about his/her life.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1867 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during July 18 – July 25, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2$ -3 per cent at 95% confidence level.
