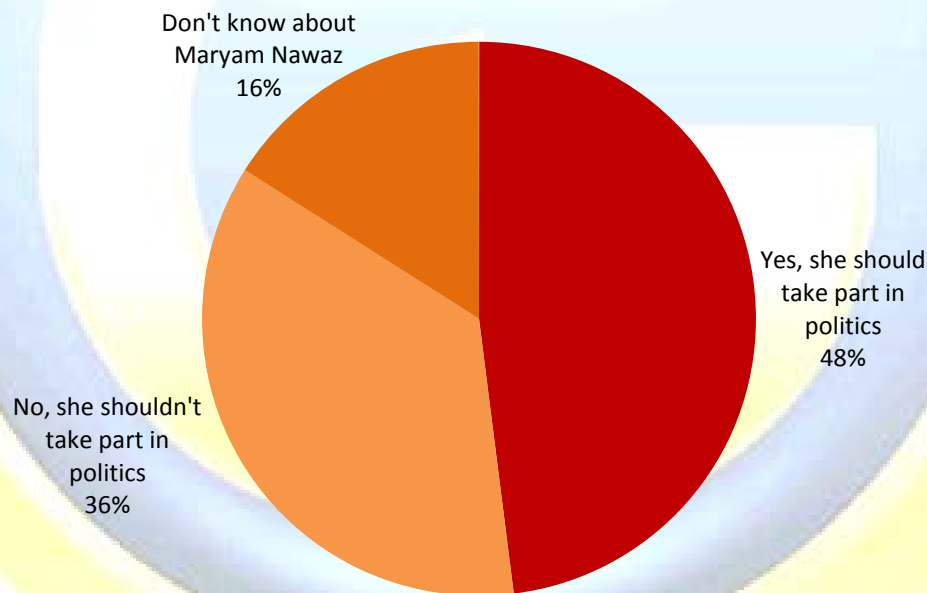
**48 % Pakistanis think that Maryam Nawaz should take part in politics; 16 % do not know about her. (GRF POLL)**

Islamabad, September 27, 2016

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 48% Pakistanis think that Maryam Nawaz should take part in politics; 16% don't know about her.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, "Some people think Maryam Nawaz should also take part in politics, while others disagree and say that Maryam Nawaz should stay away from politics. What do you think, should Maryam Nawaz take part in politics or not?" In response to this question, 48% think that yes, she should take part in politics, 36% said that no, she shouldn't take part in politics, while 16% did not know who Maryam Nawaz was.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1839 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during July 04 – July 11, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2-3$  per cent at 95% confidence level.
