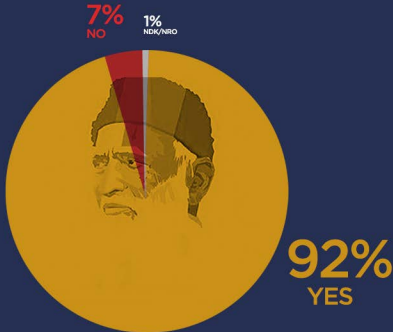

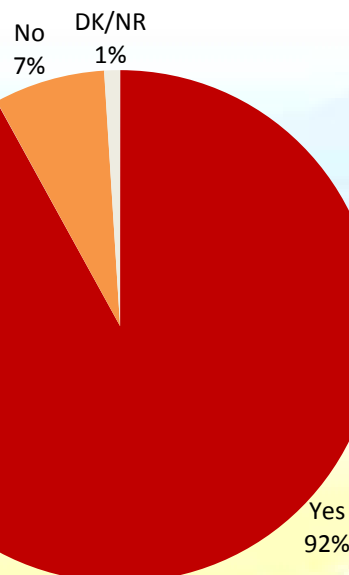
92 % Pakistanis (who know about Abdul Sattar Eidi) think that he should get a Nobel Prize. (GRF POLL)

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 92% Pakistanis (who know about Abdul Sattar Eidi) think that he should get a Nobel Prize.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, "Some people say Abdul Sattar Eidi should get a Nobel Prize; some people agree to this, others disagree. What do you think, should Eidi get a Nobel Prize?" In response to this question, 92% said that yes Eidi should get a Nobel Prize, while 7% say that no, he should not get a Nobel Prize. 1% did not know or did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1867 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during July 18 – July 25, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
