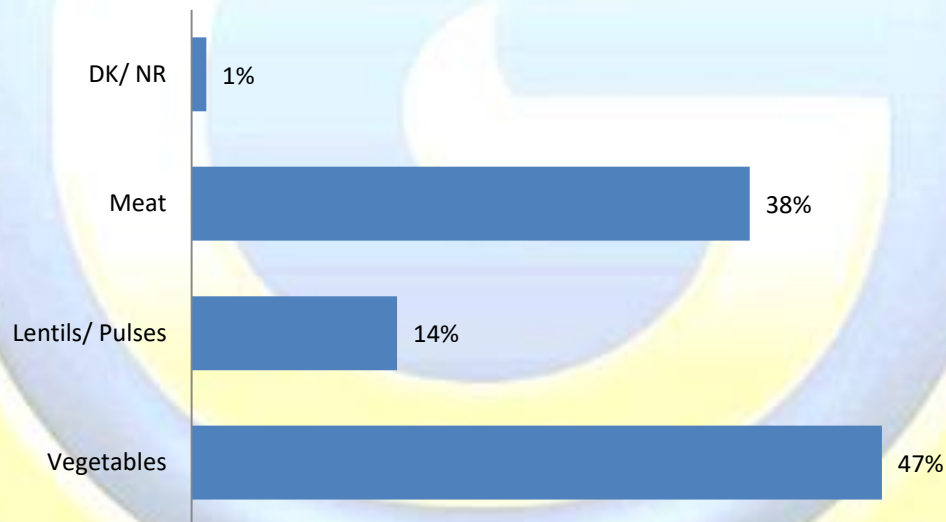
47% Pakistanis would consume vegetables; 38% would consume meat if there is no difference in their prices. (GRF POLL)

Islamabad, November 28, 2016

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 47% Pakistanis would consume vegetables; 38% would consume meat if there is no difference in their prices.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces were asked, “Imagine if there is no difference in their prices, which of the following would you consume?” In response to this question, 47% said they would consume vegetables, 14% said lentils/ pulses, 38% said meat. 1% did not know or did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1892 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 29 – September 5, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
