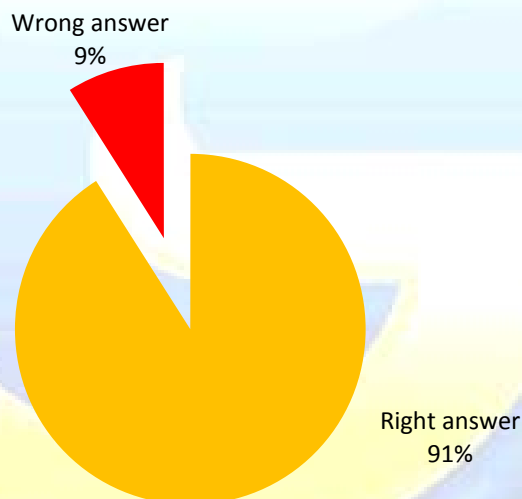

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, a significant majority (91%) of Pakistanis are aware that Quaid-e-Azam Mohammad Ali Jinnah is buried in Karachi.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Please tell, which city is Quaid-e-Azam Mohammad Ali Jinnah buried in?” In response to this question, 91% gave the right answer, 9% gave the wrong answer.

Bilal I Gilani, Executive Director Gallup Pakistan adds: “Knowledge about national history is an important predictor of patriotism and nationalist feelings. In this context, this poll presents some interesting insight.”

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1817 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 8 – August 15, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
