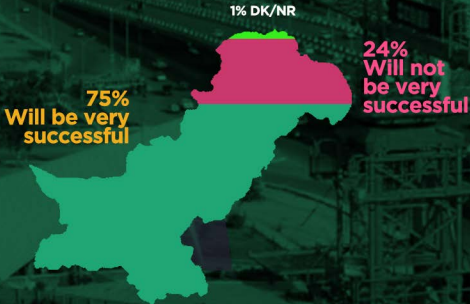

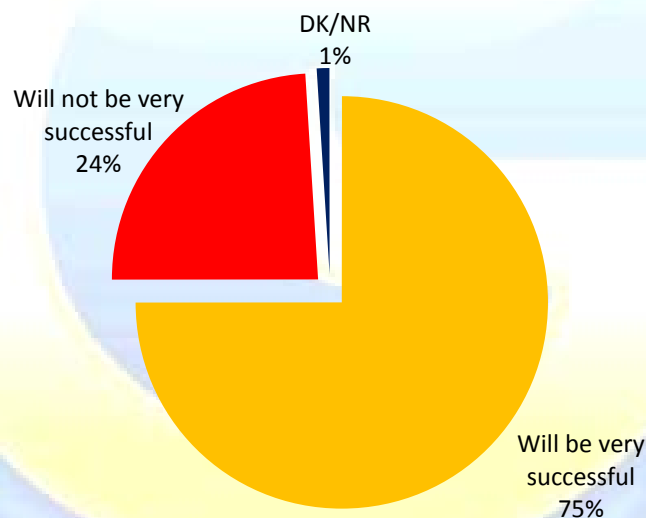
75 % Pakistanis think that Pakistan will be a very successful country in the next 30 years. (GRF POLL)

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 75% Pakistanis think that Pakistan will be a very successful country in the next 30 years.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Some people think that in the next 30 years Pakistan will not be very successful as a country, while others think Pakistan will be very successful as a country. What do you think about this?” In response to this question, 75% said that it will be very successful, while 24% said that it will not be very successful. 1% did not know or did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1817 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 8 – August 15, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
