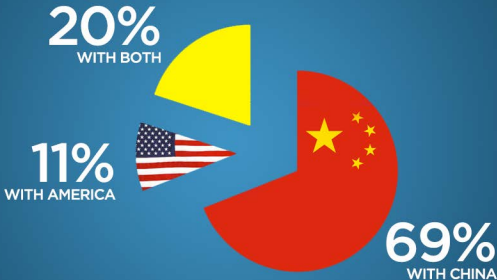


MAJORITY PAKISTANIS (69%) BELIEVE PAKISTAN SHOULD BUILD STRONG ECONOMIC TIES WITH CHINA RATHER THAN WITH USA

China / USA

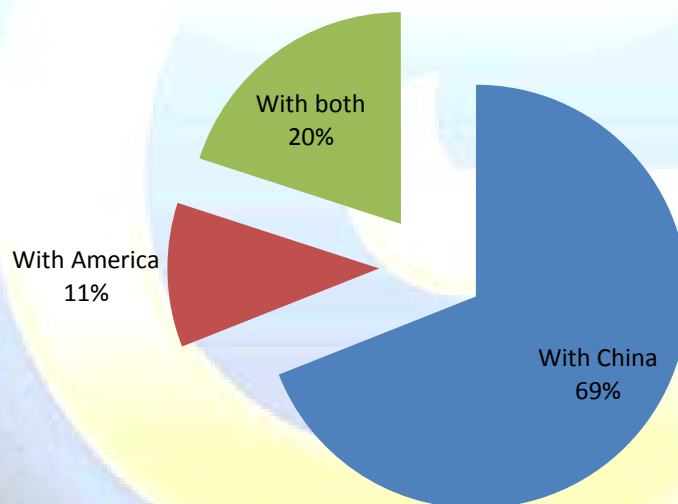
Majority Pakistanis (69%) believe Pakistan should build strong economic ties with China rather than with USA. (GRF POLL)

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, majority Pakistanis (69%) believe Pakistan should build strong economic ties with China rather than with USA.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Kindly tell in your opinion which of the two countries: America or China should Pakistan build stronger economic ties with?” In response to this question, 69% said with China, while only 11% said with America and 20% said with both countries.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1871 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during October 3– October 10, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 per cent at 95% confidence level.
