

# 1 IN 2 PAKISTANIS SAY THE PRIME MINISTER SHOULD FIRST CONTROL INFLATION; 27% SAY HE SHOULD CREATE NEW JOBS.

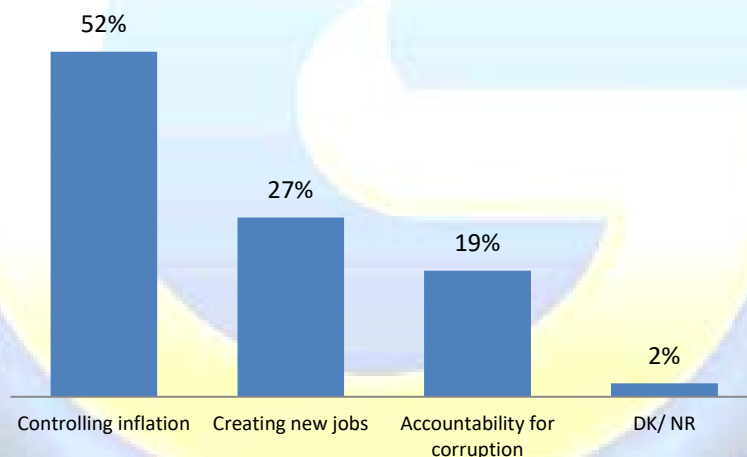
**1 in 2 Pakistanis say the Prime Minister should first control inflation;  
27 % say he should create new jobs. (GRF POLL)**

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 1 in 2 Pakistanis say the Prime Minister should first control inflation; 27% say he should create new jobs.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, "Suppose the Prime Minister asks you on telephone that which of the following three tasks he should do first. What would you suggest?" In response to this question, 52% said controlling inflation, 27% said creating new jobs while 19% said accountability for corruption. 2% did not know or did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1872 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during October 17– October 24, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2$ -3 per cent at 95% confidence level.
