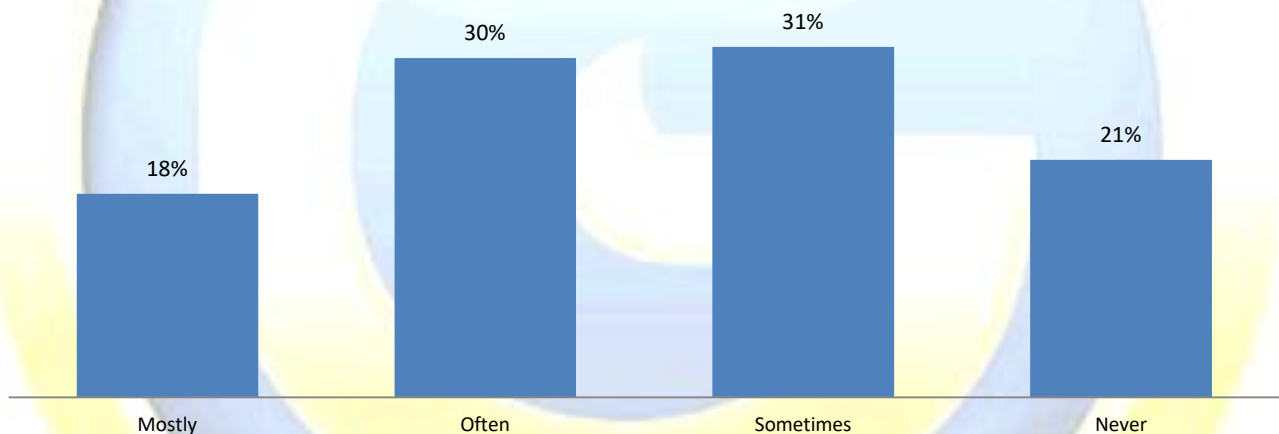
30% cable connected Pakistanis say that often cable connection goes off in their area when light goes in some other area; 31% say they sometimes face such a situation. (GRF POLL)

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, 30% cable connected Pakistanis say that often cable connection goes off in their area when light goes in some other area; 31% say they sometimes face such a situation.

A nationally representative sample of cable connected men and women from across the four provinces were asked, “Kindly tell how often do you face the following situation [When light goes in some other area, cable in your area goes as well]?” In response to this question, 18% said that cable goes in their area mostly when light goes in some other area, 30% said often, 31% said sometimes and 21% said never.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1209 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during December 5– December 12, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 per cent at 95% confidence level.
