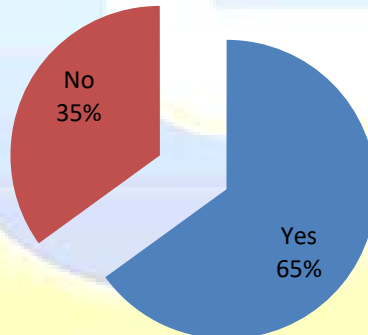
Pakistan China Economic Corridor: Dominant majority of Pakistanis (65 %) are aware of CPEC. (GRF POLL)

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, dominant majority of Pakistanis (65%) are aware of CPEC.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Last year an agreement was signed between Pakistan and India, through which a network of roads will be laid by China in Pakistan which will increase the chances of economic growth between the two countries. This agreement is called Pak China Corridor (CPEC). Have you heard or read anything about it?” In response to this question, 65% said yes, while 35% said no.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1872 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during October 17– October 24, 2016. Error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 per cent at 95% confidence level.
