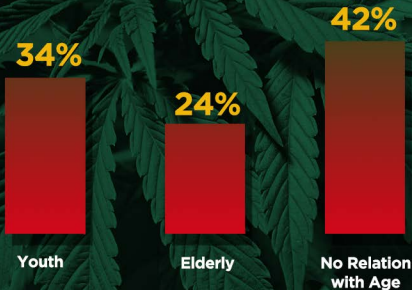

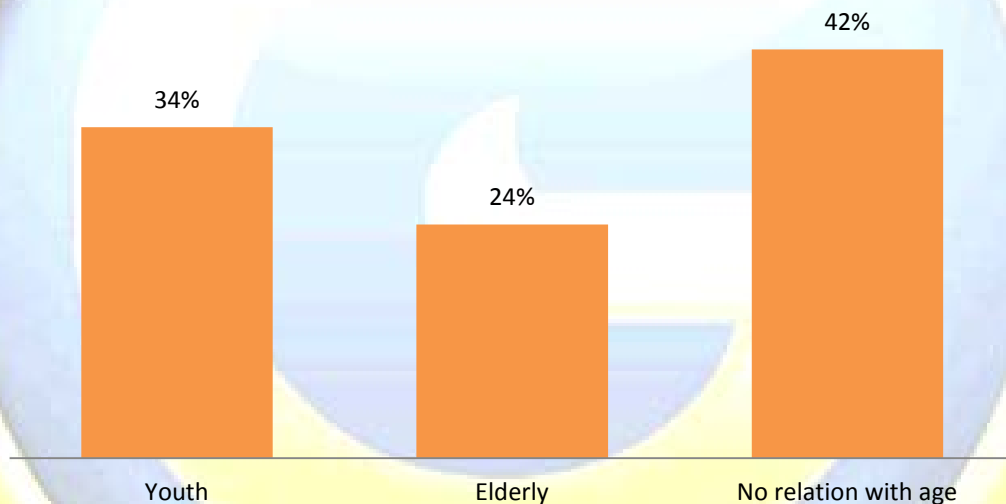
Age and narcotics use: 42 % Pakistanis say that there is no correlation between age and narcotics use. (GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)

Islamabad, March 22, 2017

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 42% Pakistanis say that there is no correlation between age and narcotics use.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “In your opinion, is use of narcotics more among the youth, or among the elderly or it does not have any relation with age?” In response to this question, 34% said the use of narcotics is more among the youth, 24% said among the elderly and 42% said use of narcotics has no relation with age.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1803 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during January 16 – January 23, 2017. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
