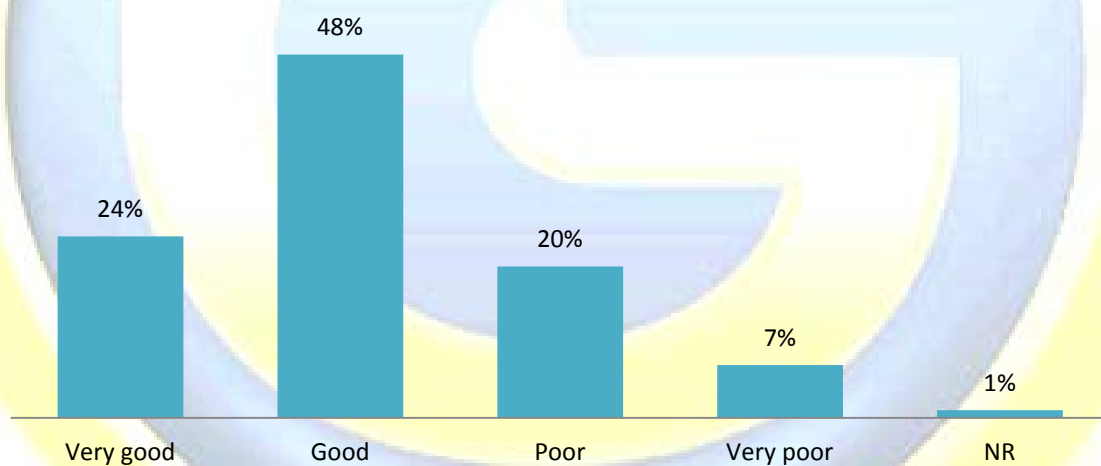

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, majority Pakistanis (72%) say that Chief Minister Sindh, Murad Ali Shah has performed well in improving the situation in Karachi.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Please tell, how do you rate the performance of Chief Minister Sindh, Murad Ali Shah in improving the situation in Karachi?” In response to this question, 24% said the performance of CM Sindh is very good in improving the situation in Karachi, 48% said good, 20% said poor, 7% said very poor and 1% did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1728 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during January 9 – January 16, 2017. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
