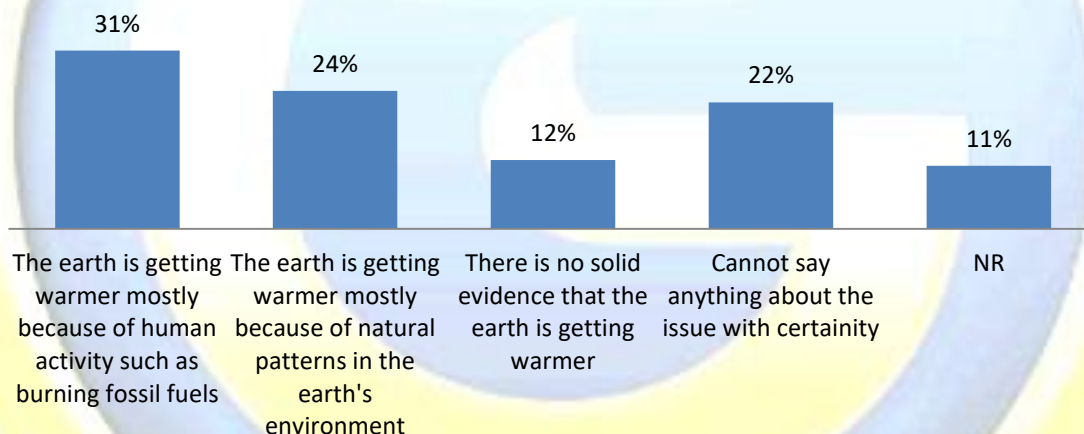
Nearly 1/3rd Pakistanis (31%) believe that human activities result in global warming. (GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)

Islamabad, April 25, 2017

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, nearly 1/3rd Pakistanis (31%) believe that human activities result in global warming.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces, “Which of these three statements about the Earth’s temperature comes closest to your view?” In response to this question, 31% said the earth is getting warmer mostly because of human activity such as burning fossil fuels, 24% said the earth is getting warmer mostly because of natural patterns in the earth’s environment, 12% said there is no solid evidence that the earth is getting warmer, 22% said cannot say anything about the issue with certainty and 11% did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1813 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during February 27 – March 06, 2017. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
