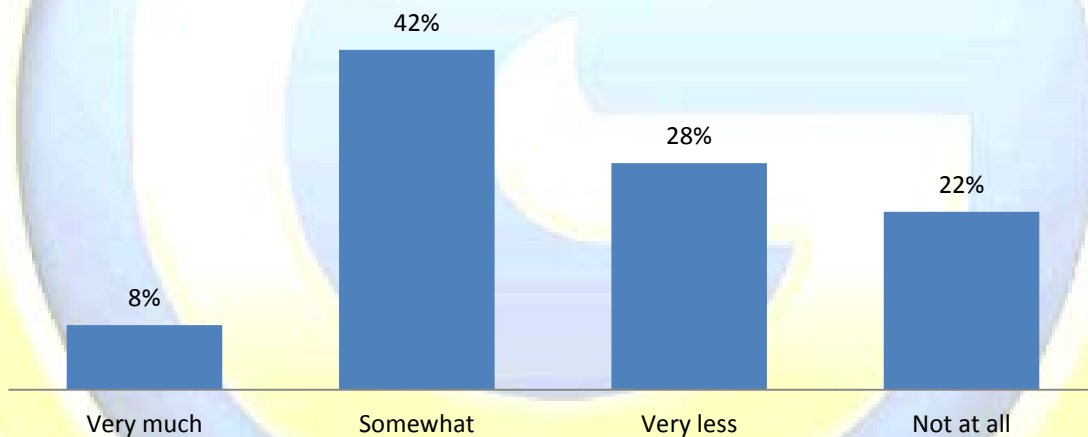
1 in 2 Pakistanis care about global climatic change. (GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)

Islamabad, April 26, 2017

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 1 in 2 Pakistanis care about global climatic change.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces, “How much do you personally care about the issue of global climate change?” In response to this question, 8% said they personally care very much about the issue of global climate change, 42% said somewhat care, 28% said very less, while 22% said not at all.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1813 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during February 27 – March 06, 2017. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
