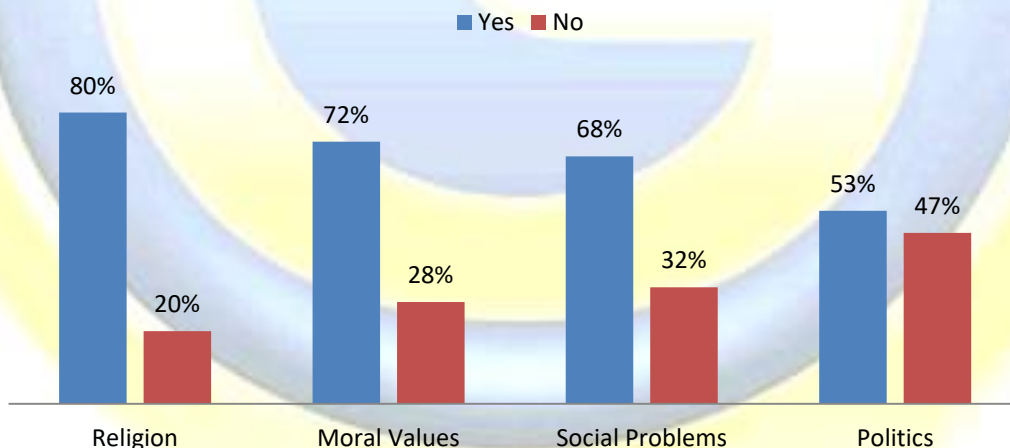

Islamabad, May 4, 2017

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, parents and children share similar opinions on societal aspects like religion, moral values and social problems as cited by majority Pakistanis. Political aspects on the other hand nurture slight differences in opinion

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Overall, in your opinion, has the trend of respect towards elders increased, decreased or remained the same in our society?” In response to this question, for religion, 80% said they and their parents share similar opinions, while 20% said otherwise. For moral values, 72% said they and their parents share similar opinions, while 28% said otherwise. For social problems, 68% said they and their parents share similar opinions, while 32% said otherwise. For politics, 53% said they and their parents share similar opinions, while 47% said otherwise.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1865 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during April 03 – April 10, 2017. Error margin is estimated to be approximately  $\pm 2-3$  per cent at 95% confidence level.
