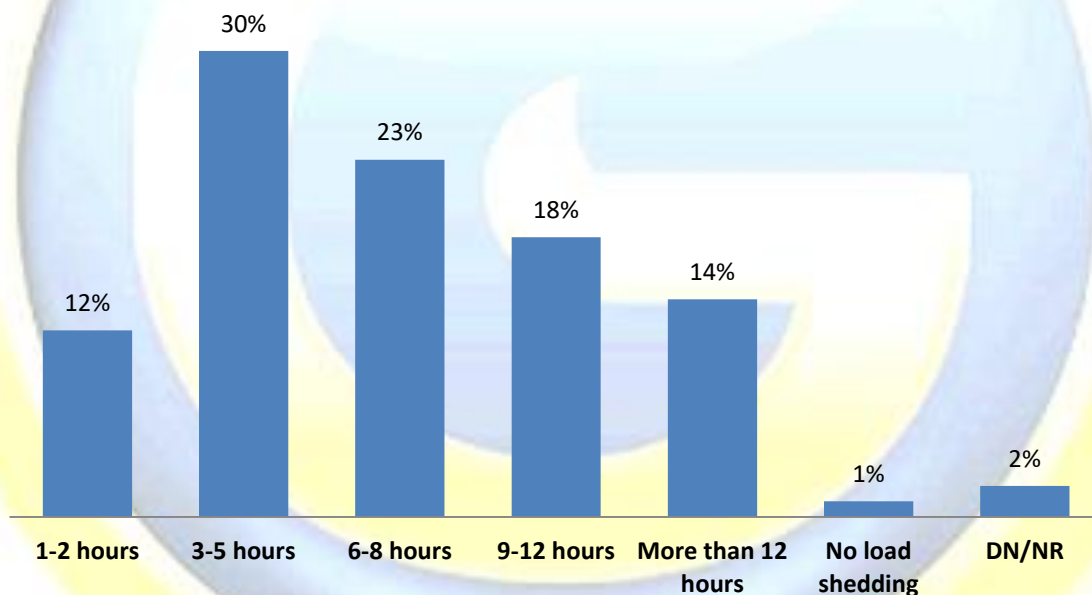
32% households claim to endure load shedding for more than 9 hours a day. (GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)

Islamabad, July 19, 2017

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 32% households claim to endure load shedding for more than 9 hours a day.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “What was the duration of load shedding in your area yesterday?” In response to this question, 12% said duration of load shedding was between 1 to 2 hours, 30% said it was between 3 to 5 hours, 23% said between 6 to 8 hours, 18% said between 9 to 12 hours, 14% said more than 12 hours. Only 1% said there was no load shedding. 2% did not know or wish to respond.

It should be noted that these figures reported in perception survey of Gallup are significantly higher by claims of Federal Government and DISCO’s in the country. This outlines a need for more accurate supply side indicators of electric supply.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1731 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during June 12 - June 19, 2017. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm$ 2-3 per cent at 95% confidence level.
