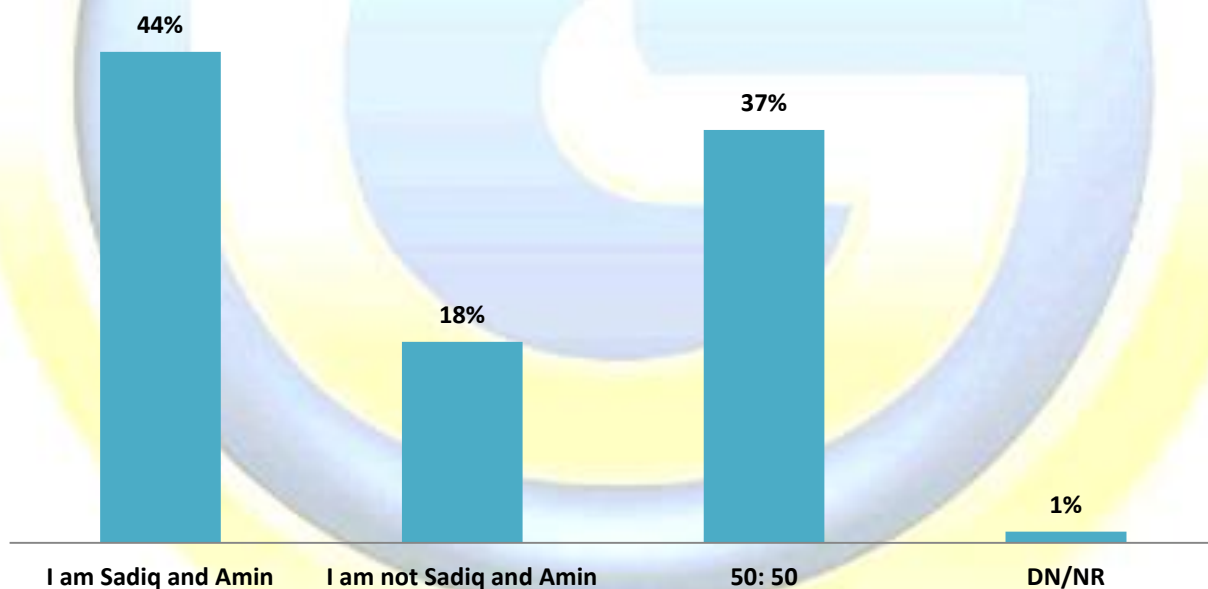
**1 in 5 Pakistanis believe they are not Sadiq and Amin.
(GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)**

Islamabad, August 17, 2017

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup and Gilani Pakistan, 1 in 5 Pakistanis believe they are not Sadiq and Amin.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked “In the Pakistani constitution there is a clause about the national elected politicians needing to be Sadiq and Amin. Some people would classify themselves as Sadiq and Amin. Others would say they are mortals and therefore may not be Sadiq and Amin. What is your opinion about yourself?” Responding to this, 44% said they were Sadiq and Amin, 18% said they were not Sadiq and Amin, 37% said 50:50 and 1% did not know or wish to respond.

Question: “In the Pakistani constitution there is a clause about the national elected politicians needing to be Sadiq and Amin. Some people would classify themselves as Sadiq and Amin. Others would say they are mortals and therefore may not be Sadiq and Amin. What is your opinion about yourself?”

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1795 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during July 31 - August 7, 2017. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
