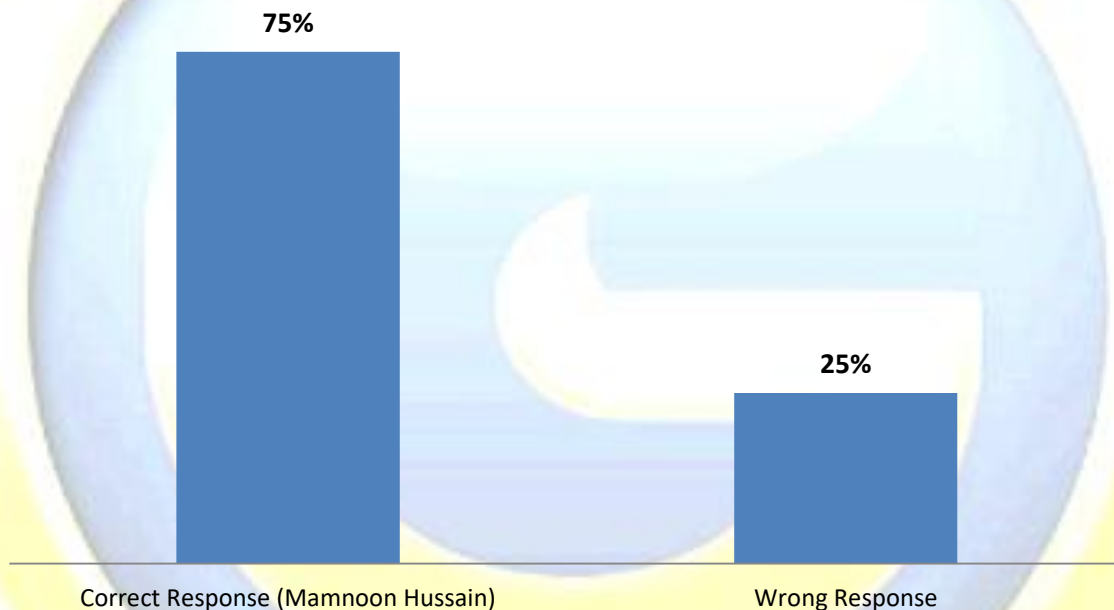
1 in 4 Pakistanis are unable to correctly name the current President of Pakistan. (GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)

Islamabad, September 21, 2017

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 1 in 4 Pakistanis are unable to correctly name the current President of Pakistan.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked “Please tell us what the name of the current president of Pakistan is.” In response, 75% Pakistanis correctly named the President of Pakistan (Mamnoon Hussain) while 25% gave an incorrect answer.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1794 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 21 – August 28, 2017. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
