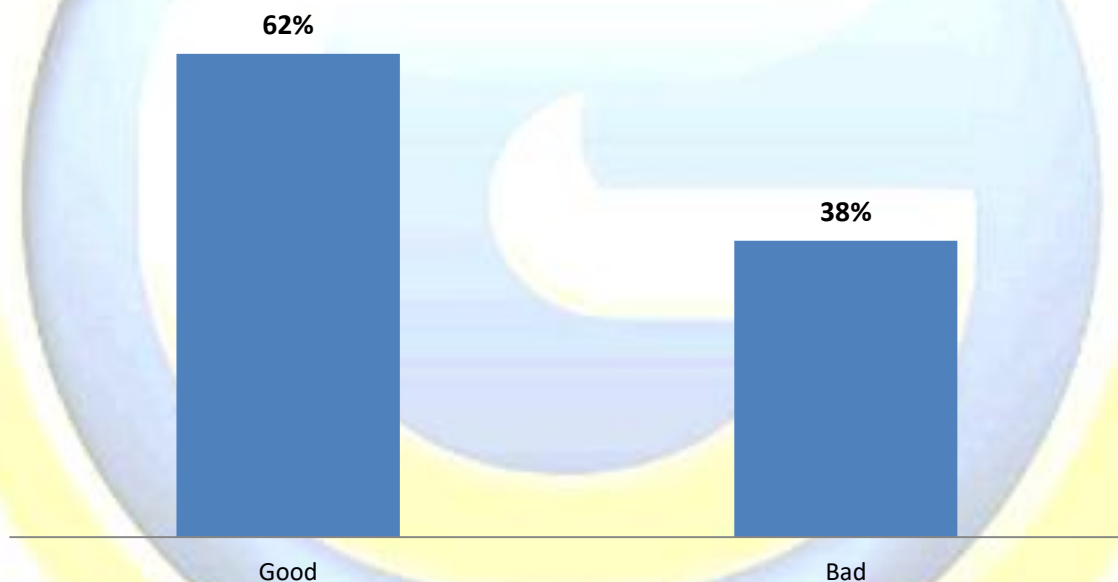
Nearly 2/3rd Pakistanis (62%) opine that settling down of Pakistani citizens abroad is a good thing for the country. (GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)

Islamabad, September 25, 2017

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, nearly 2/3rd Pakistanis (62%) opine that settling down of Pakistani citizens abroad is a good thing for the country.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked “In your opinion, is the settling down of Pakistani citizens abroad a good or bad for Pakistan?” In response, 62% said it is a good thing for Pakistan, while 38% said is a bad thing.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1797 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, September 4 –September 11, 2017. Error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 per cent at 95% confidence level.
