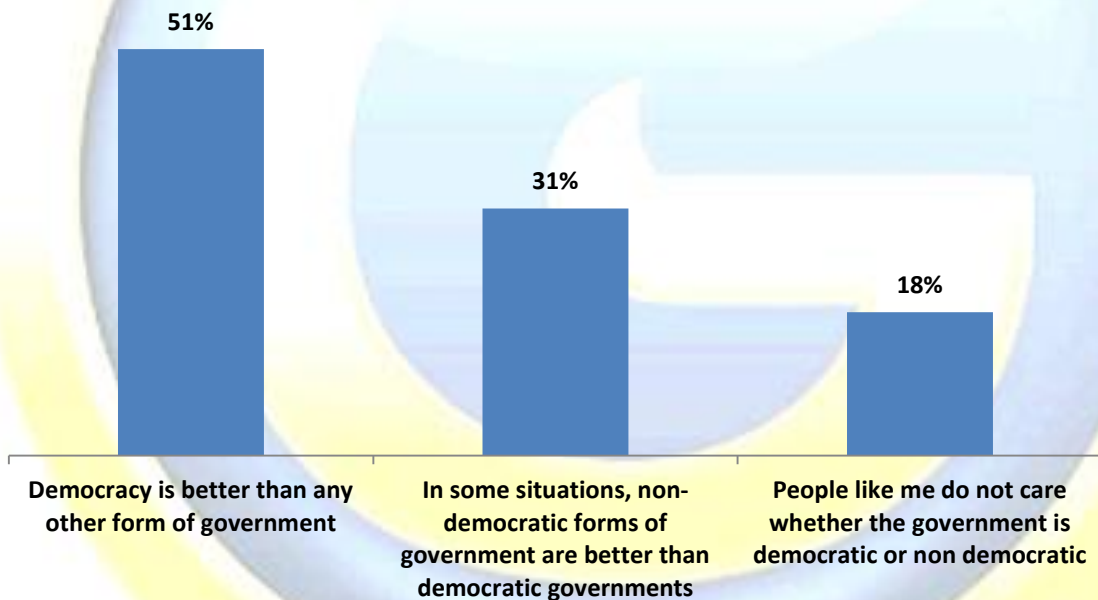
Views on Democracy: Near majority of Pakistanis (51%) opine that democracy is the best system of government. (GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)

Islamabad, September 7, 2017

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, a near majority of Pakistanis (51%) opine that democracy is the best system of government.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Which of the following statement aligns with your opinion the most?” In response to this question, 51% opined that democracy is better than any other form of government, 31% said that in some situations, non-democratic forms of government are better than democratic governments and 18% said they did not care whether the government was democratic or non-democratic.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1751 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 14 – August 21, 2017. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm$ 2-3 per cent at 95% confidence level.
