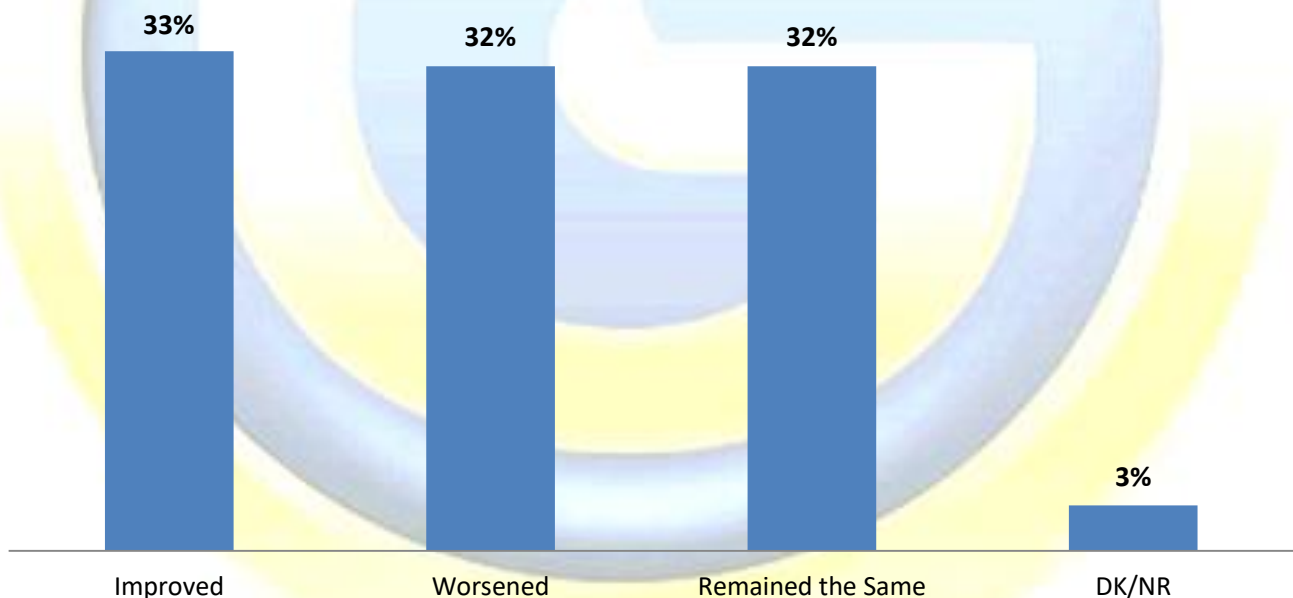
**Pakistani public opinion evenly divided over four year performance of PML-N government in maintaining law and order situations in the country.
(GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)**

Islamabad, October 27, 2017

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, Pakistani public opinion evenly divided over four year performance of PML-N government in maintaining law and order situations in the country.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked “Ever since the PML-N government has come to power, do you think Pakistan's law and order situation has improved, worsened or has it remained the same?” In response, 33% said it has improved, 32% said it has worsened, 32% said it has remained the same and 3% did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1752 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, September 25 – 01 October, 2017. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
