**69% Pakistanis opine that a public holiday should be declared across the country on Defense Day.
(GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)**

Islamabad, October 4, 2017

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 69% Pakistanis opine that a public holiday should be declared across the country on Defense Day.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked “Some people think there should be a public holiday across the country on the occasion of Defense Day, and some think otherwise. What is your opinion?” In response, 69% said that a holiday should be given across the country, while 30% said no. 1% did not respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1781 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, September 11- September 18, 2017. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
