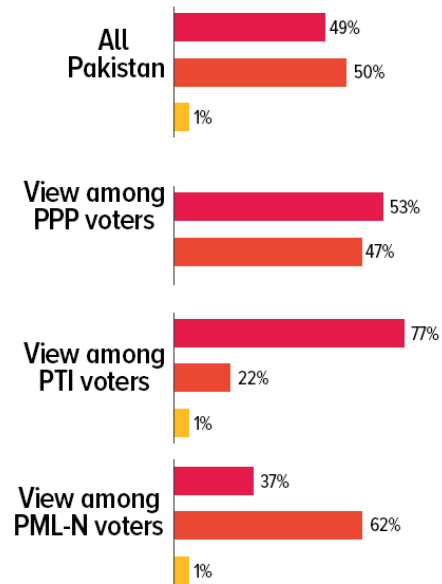
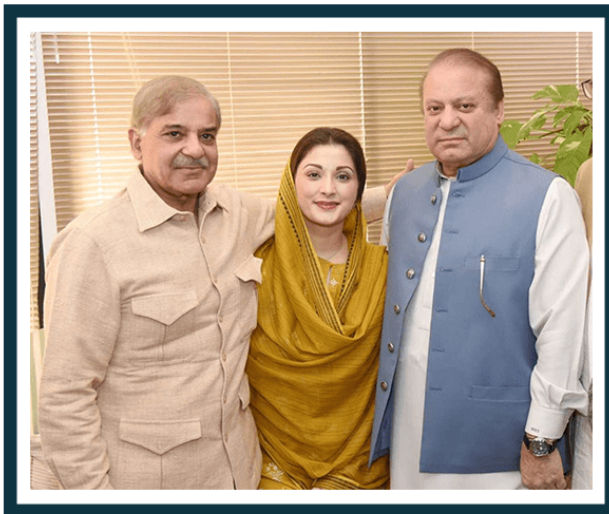

1 IN 2 PAKISTANIS (49%) SPECULATE THAT IF NAWAZ SHARIF GIVES MORE IMPORTANCE/ROLE TO MARYAM NAWAZ THAN SHAHBAZ SHARIF, PML-N WOULD THEN BREAK INTO FACTIONS. 1 IN 3 PML-N SUPPORTERS ALSO HOLD THE SAME OPINION.

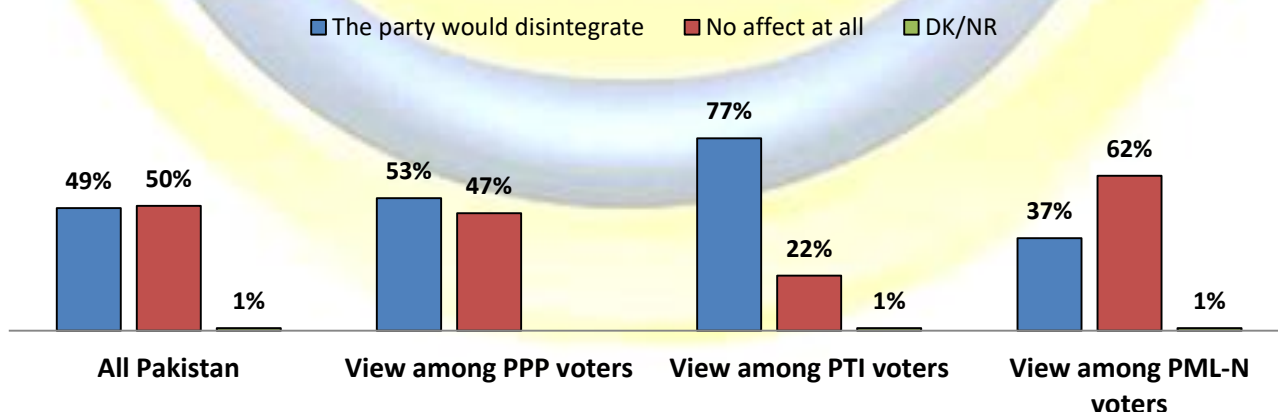
According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 1 in 2 Pakistanis (49%) speculate that if Nawaz Sharif gives more importance/role to Maryam Nawaz than Shahbaz Sharif, PML-N would then break into factions. 1 in 3 PML-N voters also hold the same opinion.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Some people say that if the former Prime Minister Nawaz Sharif tries to give more importance/role to Maryam Nawaz than Shahbaz Sharif, PML-N would then break into factions. Others believe that such a decision by Nawaz Sharif would not affect the party politics at all. What is your opinion?” In response to this question, 49% said that PML-N would break into factions and 50% said it wouldn’t affect the party politics at all. 1% did not respond.

Party-wise breakdown:

53% PPP voters said that if Nawaz Sharif tries to give more importance/role to Maryam Nawaz than Shahbaz Sharif PML-N would then break into factions, 47% said it wouldn’t affect the party politics at all. 77% PTI voters said that if Nawaz Sharif tries to give more importance/role to Maryam Nawaz than Shahbaz Sharif PML-N would then break into factions, 22% said it wouldn’t affect the party politics at all. 1% did not respond. 37% PML-N voters said that if Nawaz Sharif tries to give more importance/role to Maryam Nawaz than Shahbaz Sharif, PML-N would then break into factions, 62% said it wouldn’t affect the party politics at all and 1% did not respond.

Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
