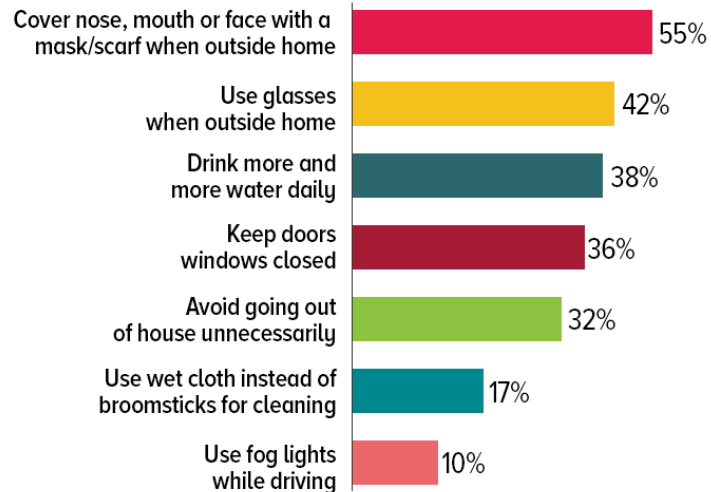

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, more than half Pakistanis (55%) feel that the best way to avoid smog is by covering oneself with a mask/scarf when outside home.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked “What are some of the way to avoid smog in your opinion?” In response, 55% said by covering nose, mouth or face with a mask/scarf when outside home, 42% said by using glasses when outside home, 38% by drinking more and more water daily, 36% said by keeping doors and windows closed, 32% said by avoiding going out of the house unnecessarily, 17% said by using wet cloth instead of a broomstick for cleaning and 10% said by using fog lights.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1826 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, November 12- November 18, 2017. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
