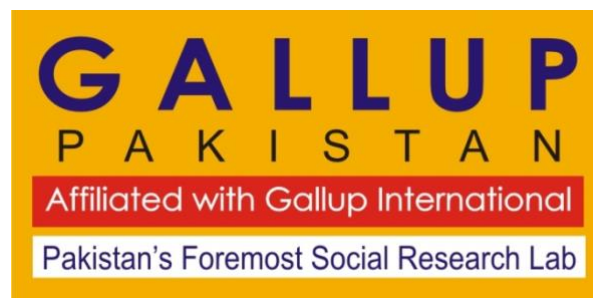

Topic 7: Merger of MQM

- Item 7.1: **Recently, (MQM) Pakistan and PSP had announced the formation of an alliance to contest the upcoming elections, under one name, one sign and one manifesto. However, the very next day, they decided to cancel the alliance and continue to maintain the individual flag, election mark and manifesto of each political party. Some people believe that the alliance between MQM and PSP was the right decision while others believe that the decision**



to not form an alliance was right. Which decision was correct in your opinion?

Item 7.2: **Some think that if the two political parties had united, Karachi's peace would have been restored and the people of Karachi would have benefitted from this alliance. Some thought that political parties would have gained the most benefit themselves. Tell me who would have benefitted the most in your opinion?**

Item 7.3: **Some people think of the alliance between PSP and MQM, didn't work out majorly because of PSP, while others believe that the MQM leaders were responsible for the failure of the alliance. Please tell us what is your personal opinion about this?**

Item 7.4: **Please tell which party has benefitted the most by the failure of this alliance/union?**

Executive Summary

Topic 1: Karachi Operation

Satisfaction with operation: 84% satisfied; 4% dissatisfied now

Following up, people were asked how satisfied they were with the operation. Responding to this, **41%** said they were very satisfied, **43%** said they were somewhat satisfied and **9%** replied they were neither satisfied nor dissatisfied. **3%** of the respondents stated they were dissatisfied and **1%** said they were very dissatisfied whereas **3%** did not respond.

Target Killing: 73% decreased; 13% said there was no change

The general public was then asked to respond regarding the frequency in occurrence of certain events. When asked about the incidence of target killing, **73%** said it has decreased, **9%** said that it increased and **13%** said there has been no change. **4%** in did not respond.

Mobile Phone Theft: 56% decreased; 13% said there was no change

In response to the incidence of mobile phone theft, **56%** said it had decreased, **26%** said it increased, **13%** said there was no change and **5%** did not respond.

Decrease in Kidnaping for Ransom: 68% decreased; 8% increased

When questioned about the frequency of kidnapping for ransom in November, **68%** said the number of incidents had decreased, **8%** said they had increased and **13%** said there was no change. **11%** did not respond.

Car Theft: 65% decreased; 10% increased

Responding to the occurrence of car theft, **65%** said it had decreased, **10%** said it had increased and **14%** said there was no change. **10%** did not respond.

Extortion: 76% decreased; 7% increased

When questioned on the frequency of extortion, **7%** said it had increased, **76%** responded that it had decreased and **9%** said there was no change. **8%** did not respond.

Ranger's Performance: Satisfaction at 82%

Respondents were asked to weigh in on the performance of Rangers. **36%** said they were very satisfied with the Rangers' performance, **46%** said they were somewhat satisfied, **11%** said they were neither satisfied nor dissatisfied and **5%** were dissatisfied.

Duration of Operation: 80% say till peace is restored

People were then questioned on how long they thought the Karachi operation should last. In response, **2%** said less than one month. **2%** said the operation should last for 6 months compared to **80%** who responded that



the operation should last until peace is completely restored in Karachi. **13%** did not respond.

Bias in Operation: Perception of biasedness stands at 22%

When asked if in their opinion the Karachi Operation is biased or not, **22%** responded it is biased compared to **62%** who replied this was not the case. **16%** did not respond.

Topic 2: Role of Political Parties

Criminals in Political Parties: 17% MQM (Altaf); 13% PPP

When asked which party they thought had the most criminals, **17%** said MQM (Altaf group), **13%** said PPP, **1% each** said ANP, MQM Farooq, PSP, and Jamat –i-Islami (JI) and **15%** said PML-N/Federal Government, **47%** said all parties had criminals, **2%** said none and **1%** did not respond.

Responsible for Karachi's Condition: 14% PPP; 15% MQM (Altaf); 25% PML-N

In reference to the current conditions of Karachi, people were asked who they held most responsible for such bad conditions. In response, **14%** said PPP, **11%** said the police, **15%** said MQM (Altaf) and **25%** said PML-N/Federal Government. **1%** of the respondents each mentioned the ANP, PTI, PSP, MQM (Farooq) and Sunni Tehreek. **1%** blamed the Rangers and **2%** said intelligence agencies.

Resolve Security and Peace Problems: 20% feel that Rangers should be called in to restore peace in Karachi, 13% say MQM (Farooq)

The general population was asked which political party can best the security and peace problems in Karachi. In response, **4%** said MQM Altaf, **13%** said MQM Farooq, **9%** said PSP, **8%** each said PPP and PTI, **6%** said PML-N, **20%** said Rangers, **20%** said all, **8%** said none and **2%** did not know.

Topic 3: Perspective on newly-formed political party Pak Sarzameen Party

Formation of new political party Pak Sar Zameen: 53% say Mustafa Kamal's new political party will be successful; 35% say it will be unsuccessful

Regarding Mustafa Kamal's new party, respondents were asked they felt Mustafa Kamal's new political party will be successful or not. **16%** said that Mustafa Kamal's new political party will be very successful, **37%** said that it will be successful to some extent, **20%** said that there is no chance of success and **15%** said that there is no chance of success at all. **12%** did not respond.

Topic 4: Public Opinion on Political Figures



Farooq Sattar: 55% hold positive opinion, 40% hold negative opinion

Respondents were asked about their opinion regarding Farooq Sattar. 16% said very good, 39% said good, 19% said bad, 21% said very bad and 4% did not respond.

Altaf Hussain: 18% hold positive opinion, 73% hold negative opinion

Respondents were asked about their opinion regarding Altaf Hussain. 4% said very good, 14% said good, 30% said bad, 43% said very bad and 9% did not respond.

Amir Khan: 24% hold positive opinion, 64% hold negative opinion

Respondents were asked about their opinion regarding Amir Khan. 6% said very good, 18% said good, 35% said bad, 29% said very bad and 12% did not respond.

Waseem Akhtar: 29% hold positive opinion, 58% hold negative opinion

Respondents were asked about their opinion regarding Waseem Akhtar. 6% said very good, 23% said good, 26% said bad, 32% said very bad and 13% did not respond.

Ishrat ul Ibad: 28% hold positive opinion, 51% hold negative opinion

Respondents were asked about their opinion regarding Ishrat ul Ibad. 8% said very good, 20% said good, 23% said bad, 28% said very bad and 20% did not respond.

Babar Khan Ghauri: 17% hold positive opinion, 60% hold negative opinion

Respondents were asked about their opinion regarding Babar Khan Ghauri. 3% said very good, 14% said good, 24% said bad, 36% said very bad and 23% did not respond.

Mustafa Kamal: 42% hold positive opinion, 47% hold negative opinion

Respondents were asked about their opinion regarding Mustafa Kamal. 10% said very good, 32% said good, 23% said bad, 24% said very bad and 10% did not respond.

Asif Ali Zardari: 17% hold positive opinion, 71% hold negative opinion

Respondents were asked about their opinion regarding Asif Ali Zardari. 4% said very good, 13% said good, 26% said bad, 45% said very bad and 13% did not respond.

Bilawal Bhutto: 21% hold positive opinion, 63% hold negative opinion

Respondents were asked about their opinion regarding Bilawal Bhutto. 4% said very good, 17% said good, 29% said bad, 34% said very bad and 16% did not respond.

Syed Murad Ali Shah: 28% hold positive opinion, 55% hold negative opinion



Respondents were asked about their opinion regarding Syed Murad Ali Shah. 4% said very good, 24% said good, 23% said bad, 32% said very bad and 18% did not respond.

Hafiz Naeem Ur Rehman: 29% hold positive opinion, 47% hold negative opinion

Respondents were asked about their opinion regarding Hafiz Naeem Ur Rehman. 8% said very good, 21% said good, 21% said bad, 26% said very bad and 24% did not respond.

Shahi Sayed: 22% hold positive opinion, 55% hold negative opinion

Respondents were asked about their opinion Shahi Sayed. 6% said very good, 16% said good, 24% said bad, 31% said very bad and 24% did not respond.

Topic 5: Voting Intention

Voting Intention for Next Elections: 18% mention MQM (Farooq Group); 12% mention PSP

Respondents were asked which political party they would vote for in the next elections. 5% mentioned MQM (Altaf Group), 18% said MQM (Farooq Sattar), 1% said MQM (Afaq Group), 12% said PSP (Mustafa Kamal), 6% said PML-N, 8% said PTI and 9% said PPP. On the other hand, 1% each mentioned Jamat-e-Islami and ANP. Another 12% said they will not cast their vote, and 1% said others. 26% did not respond. The percentage of respondents voting for the MQM (Farooq Group) has risen by 2% since the previous way in April 2017. Meanwhile, voting intention for PSP has decline from 29% to 12% in the current wave.

Topic 6: Division of MQM (MQM London and MQM Pakistan)

3 in 5 respondents say the division of MQM from Altaf Hussain was right

When asked about the division of MQM, 59% said it was right, 22% said it was wrong and 20% did not respond.

Topic 7: Merger of MQM

Alliance between MQM and PSP: 37% favor; 49% oppose

Respondents were asked whether they believed that the alliance between MQM and PSP was the right decision or the decision to not form an alliance was right. 37% favored formation of alliance while 49% favored the cancellation of the alliance and the maintenance of individual identity of each party. 14% did not know.



Alliance between MQM and PSP: 45% respondents believe that political parties would have been the primary beneficiaries of the alliance

Respondents were asked who would have benefitted the most from the alliance. In response, 45% political parties, 34% said people of Karachi and 21% did not respond.

49% blame leaders of MQM-P for the failure of alliance

Respondents were further asked who was responsible for the failure of the alliance. In response, 49% said leaders of MQM-P, 23% said leaders of PSP and 28% did not know.

25% believe PTI has benefitted the most from the failure of alliance.

Respondents were further asked which party has benefitted the most by the failure of this alliance/union. In response, 6% said PML-N, 25% said PTI, 20% said PPP, 4% said JI, 2% said JUI-F, 1% said all parties and 42% did not respond.

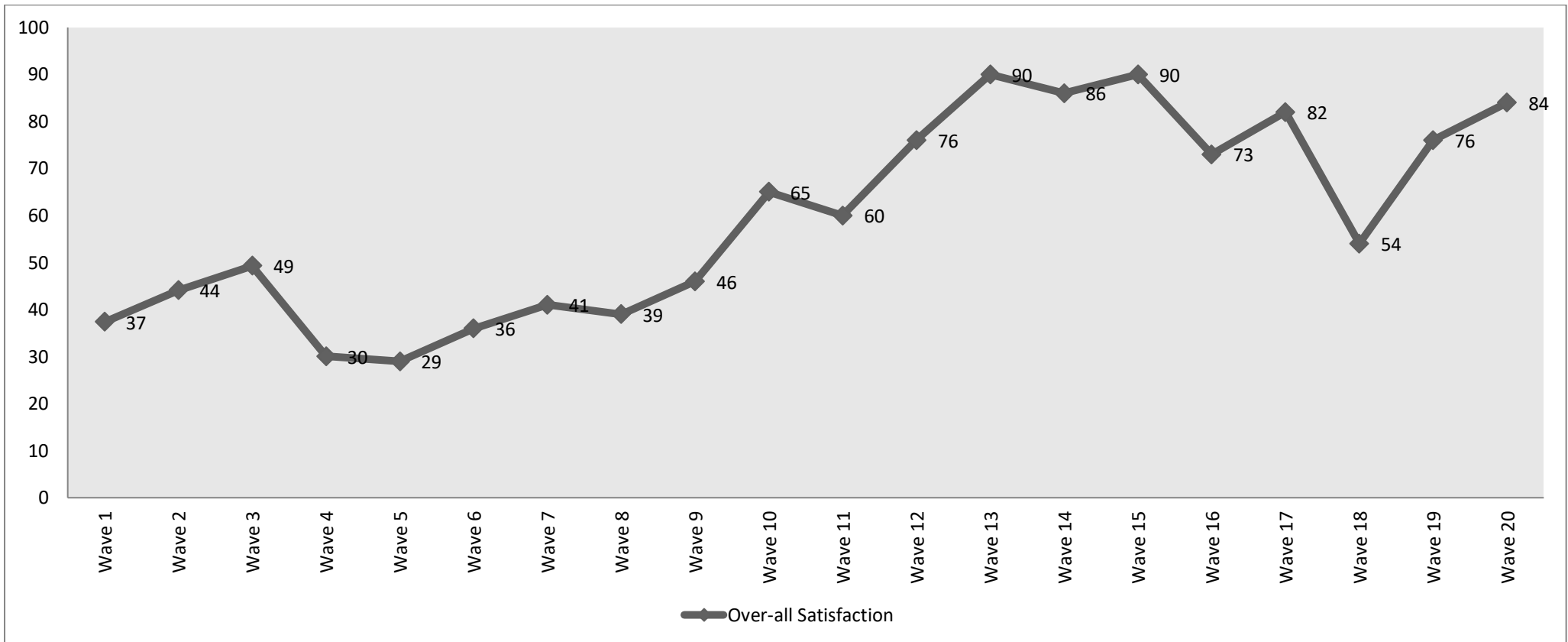


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Summary Indexes on Trend Data

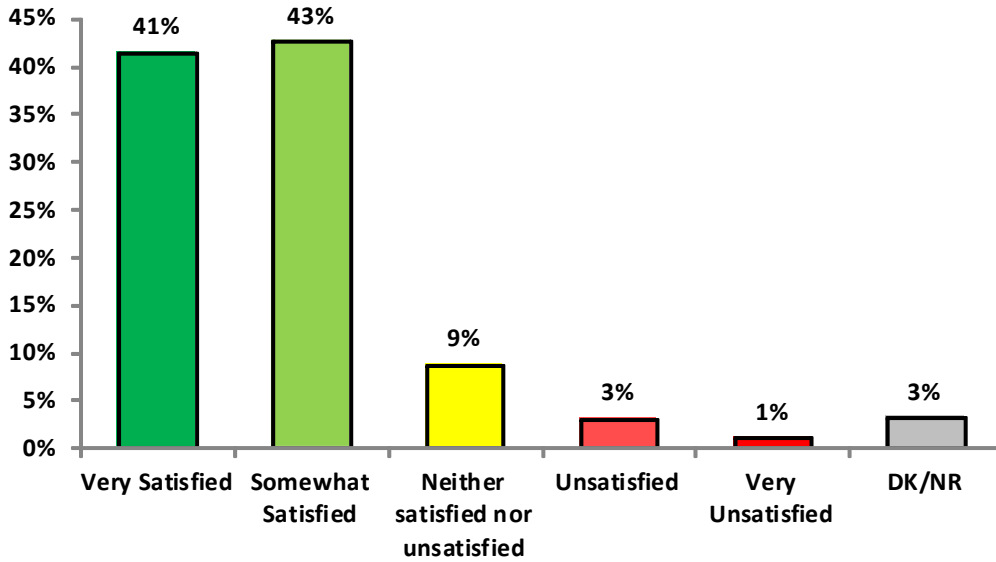

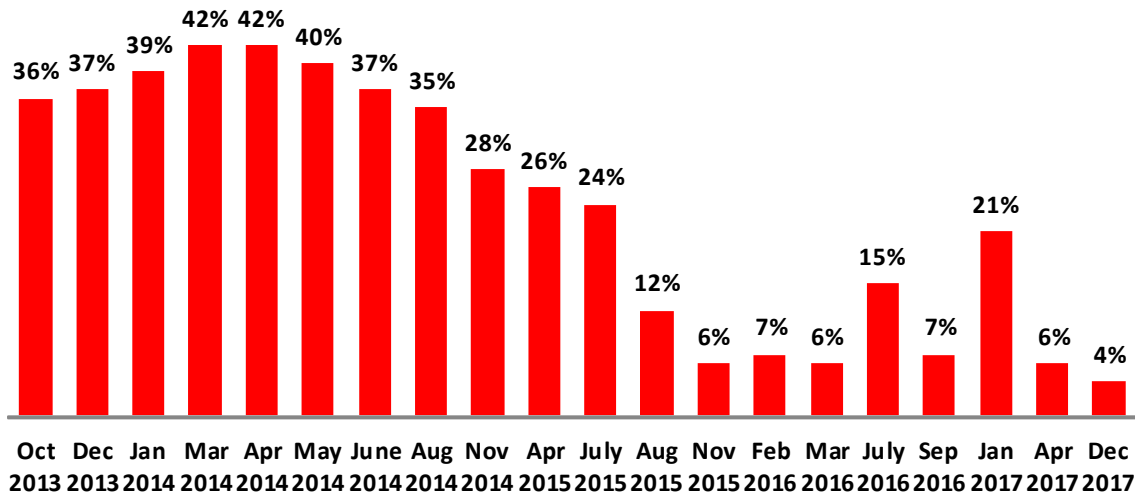

■ Very Unsatisfied + Somewhat Unsatisfied

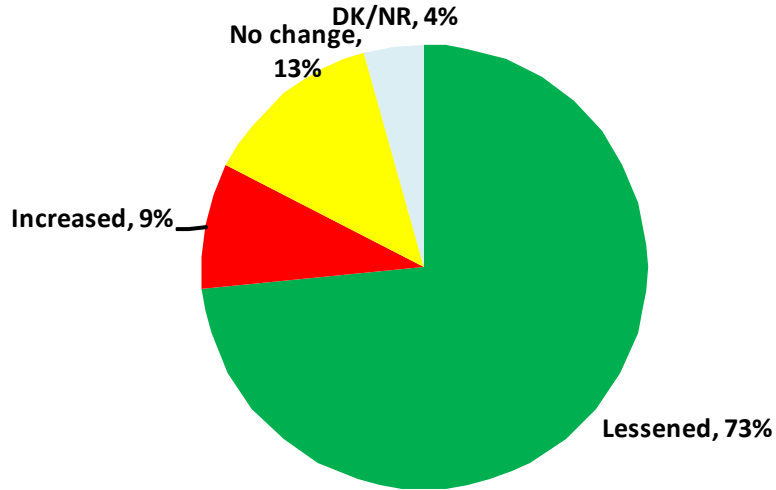

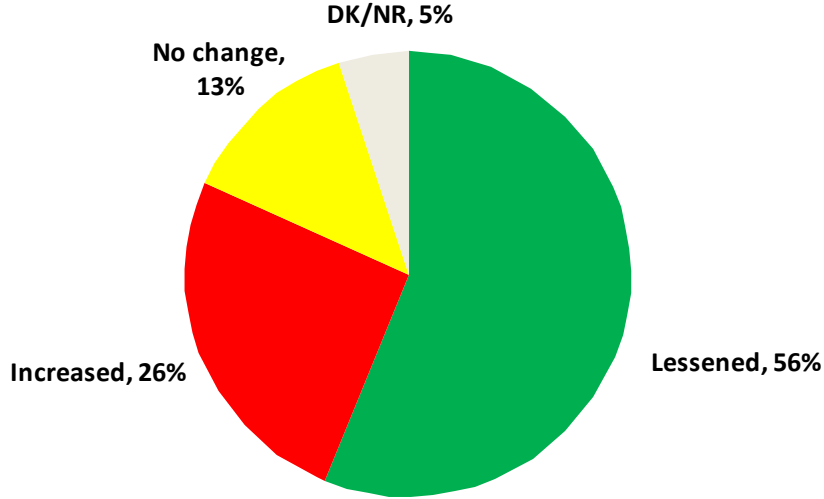

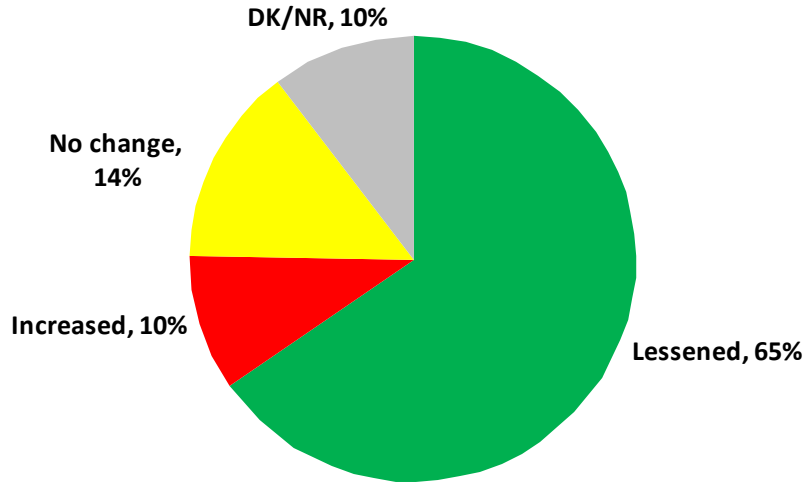

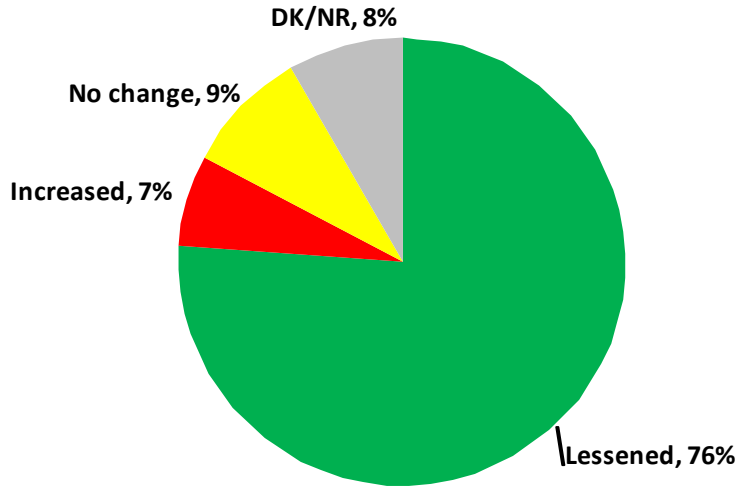

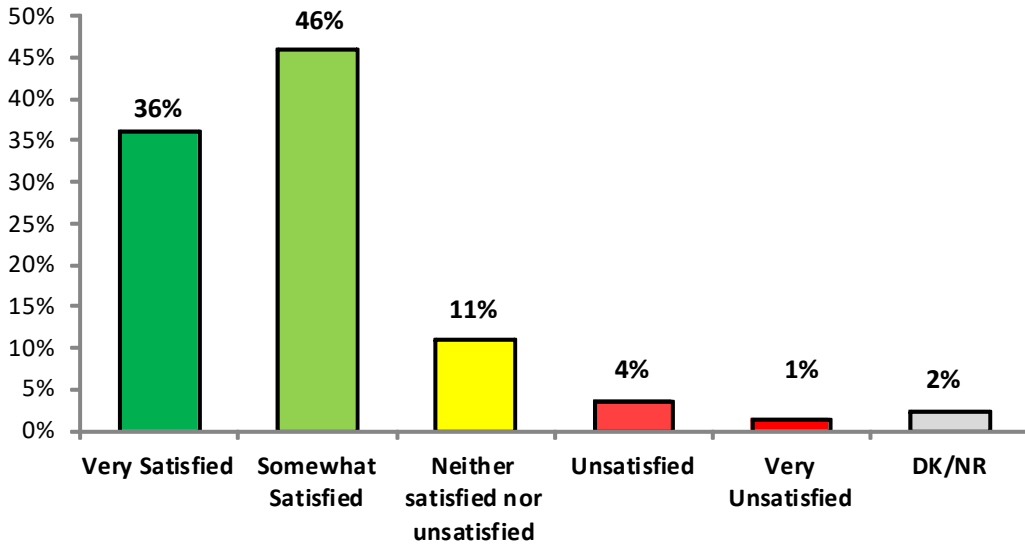

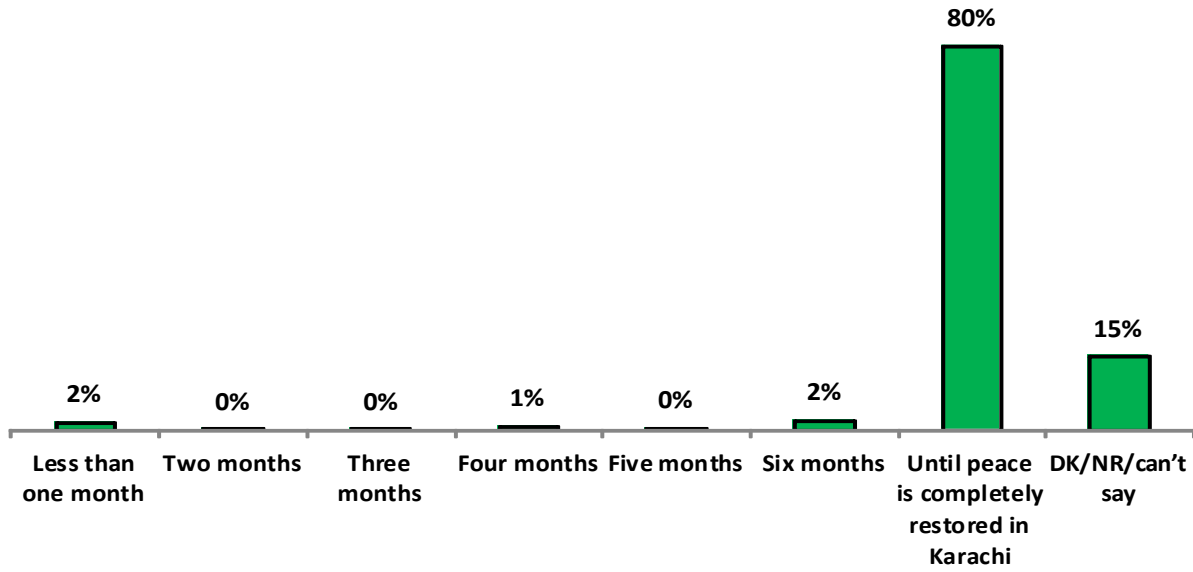

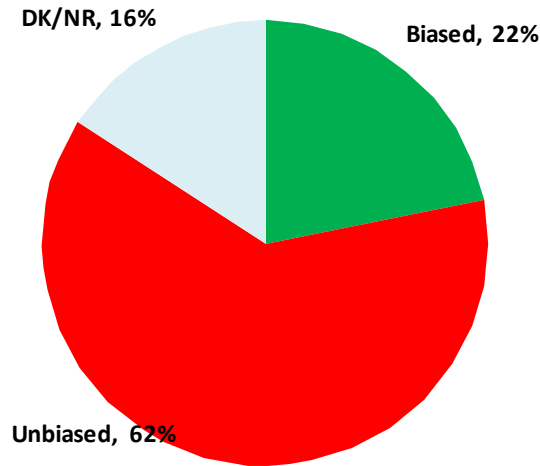

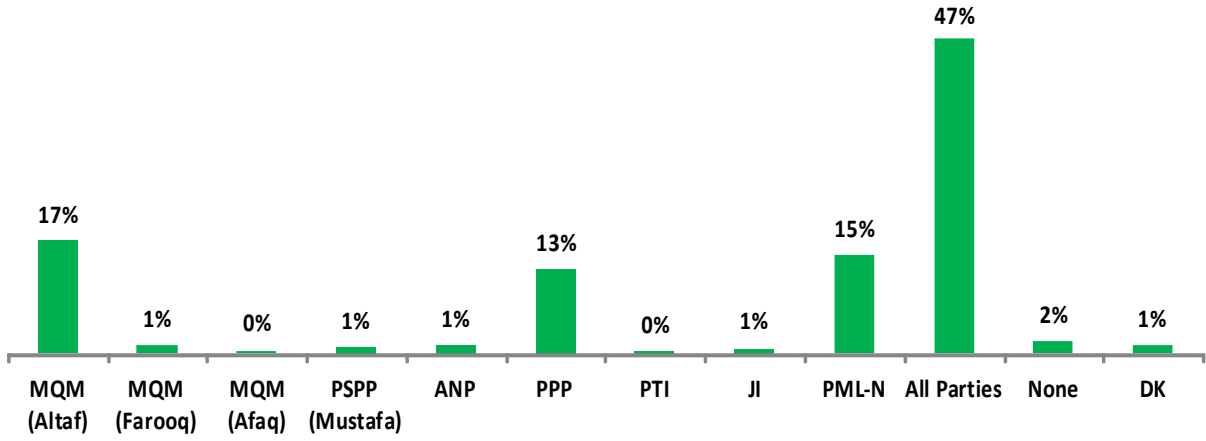

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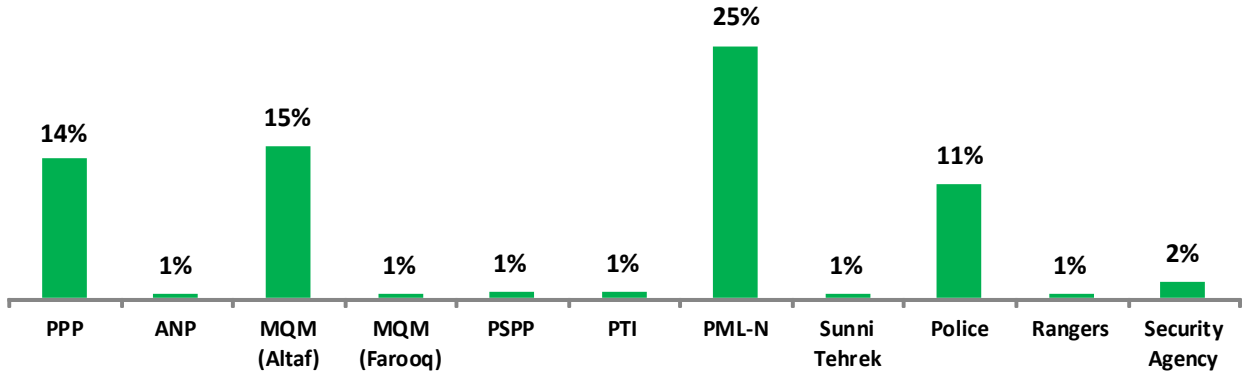

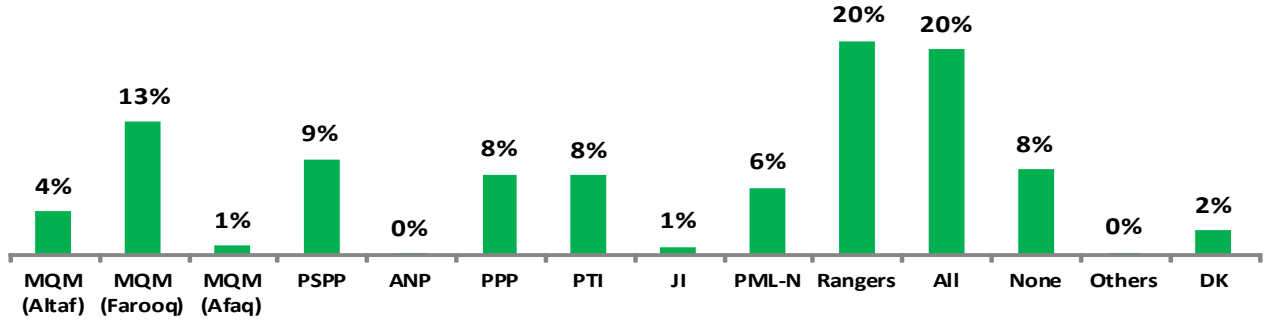

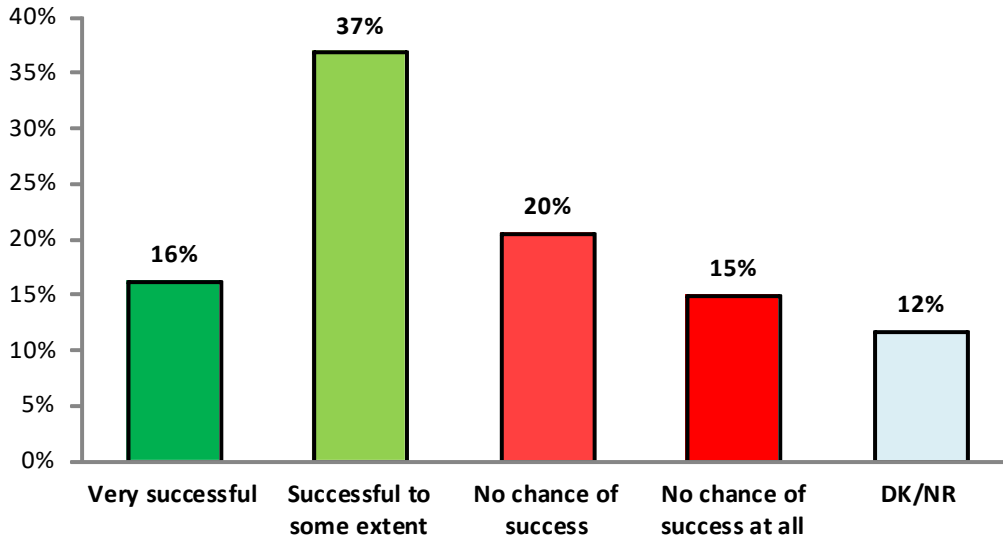

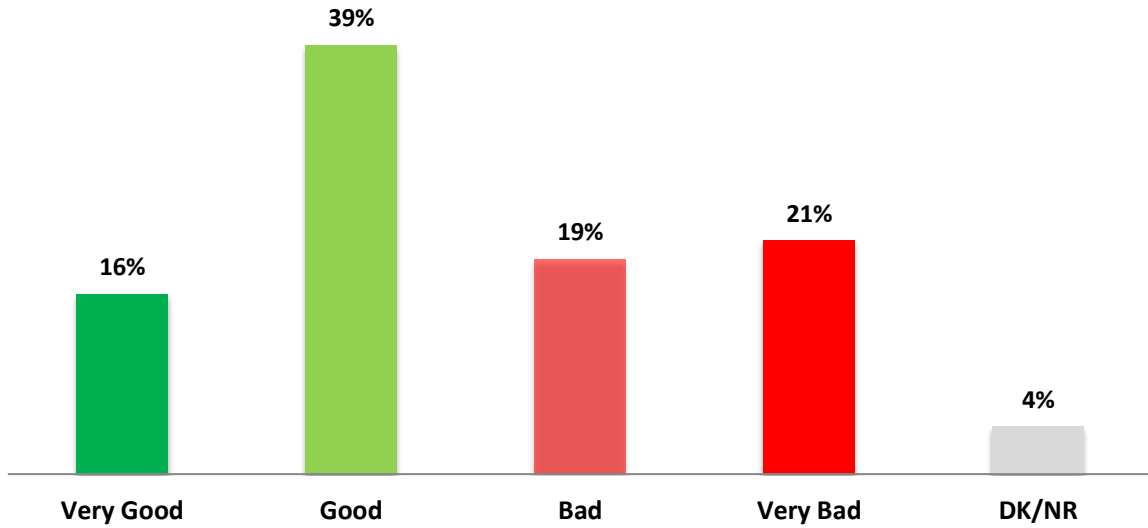

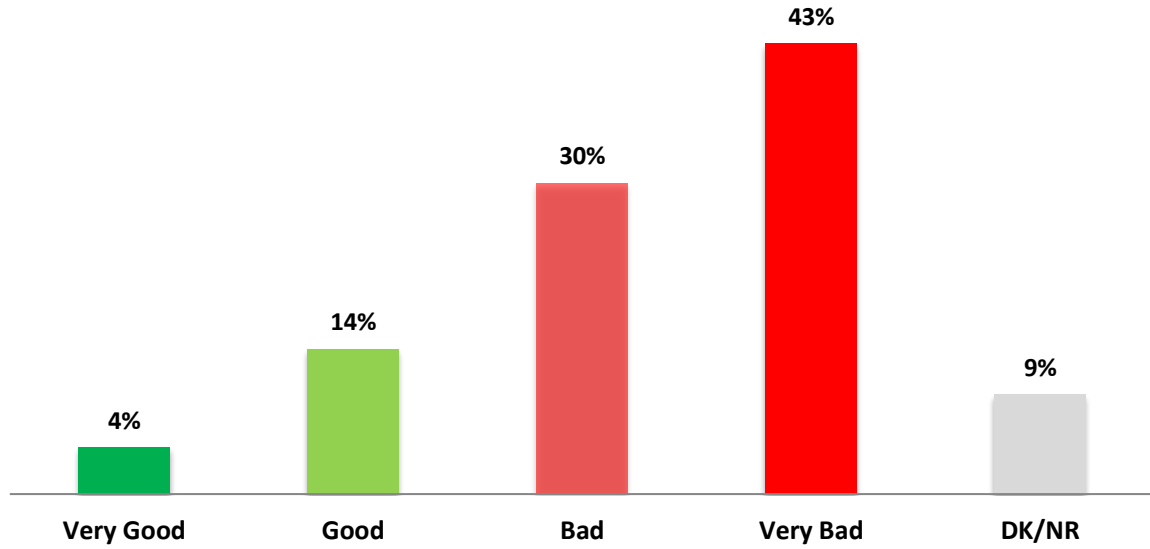

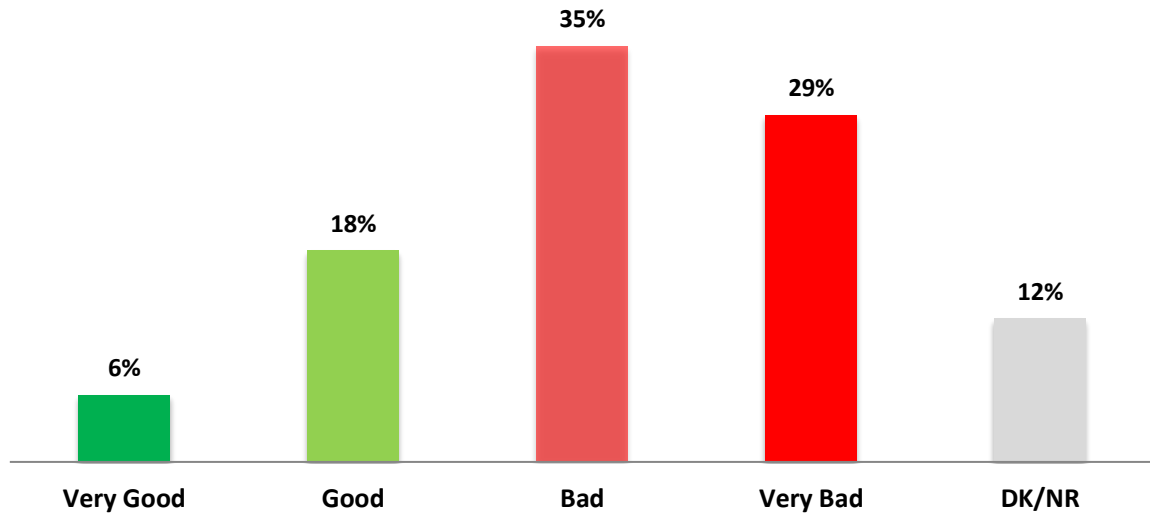

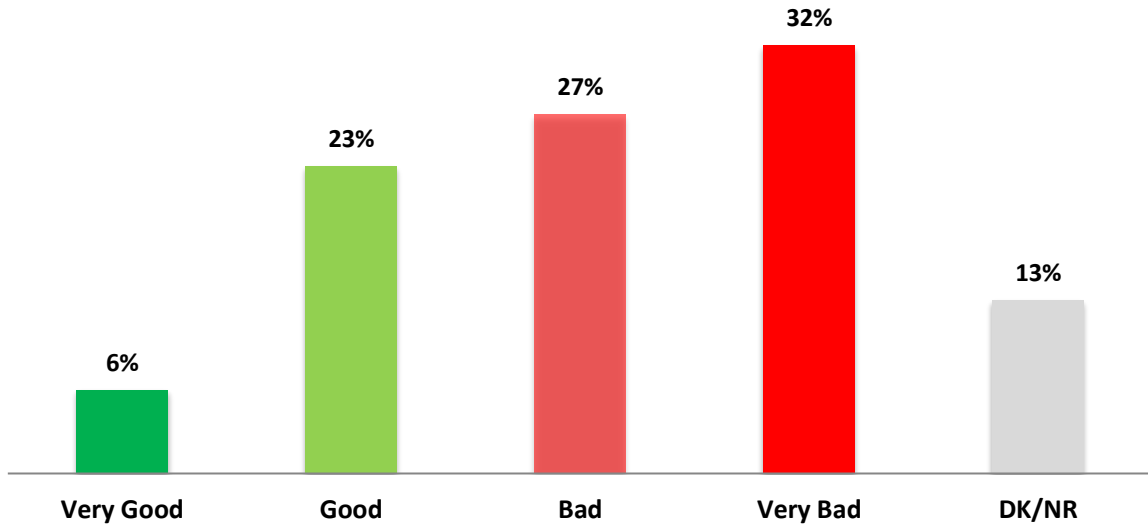

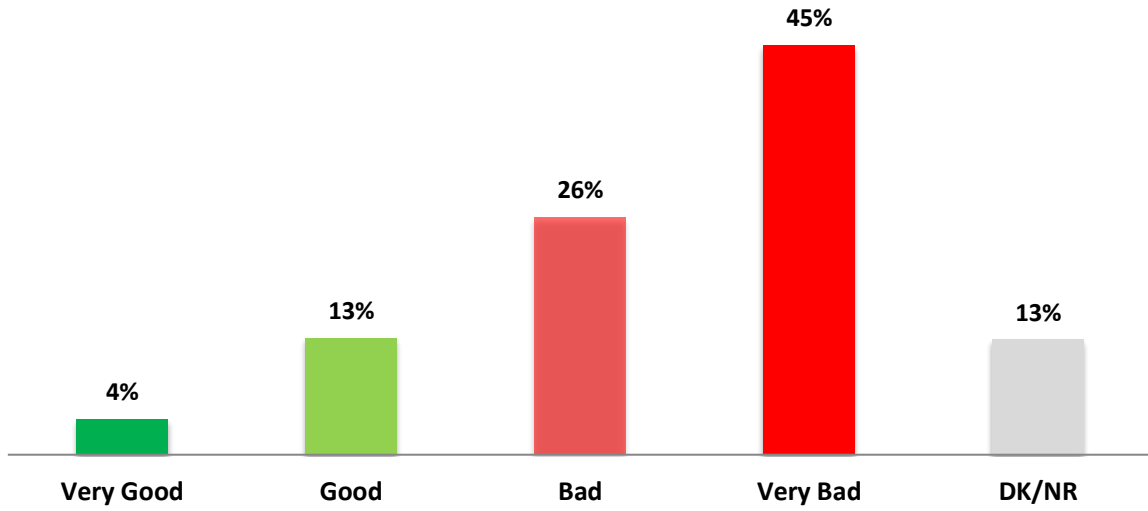

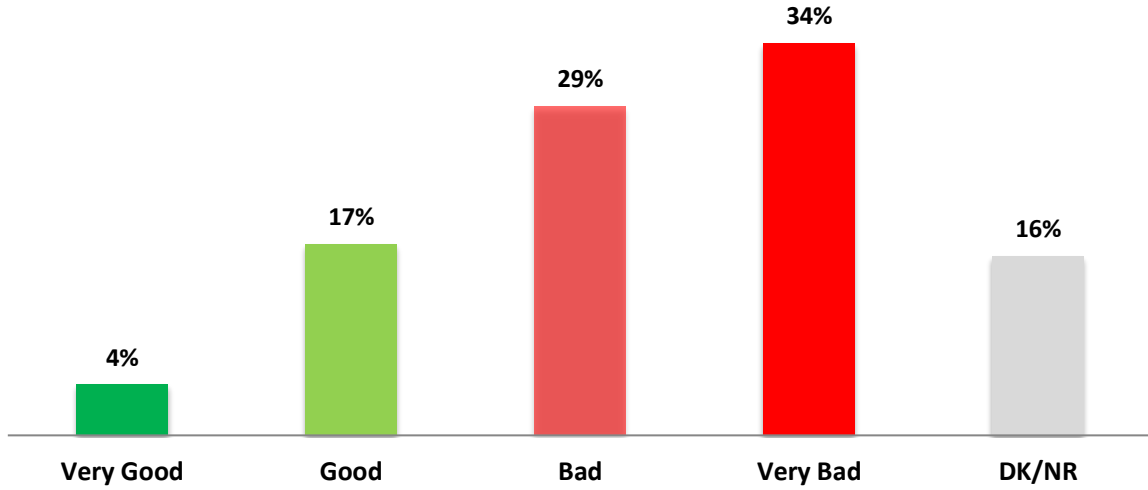

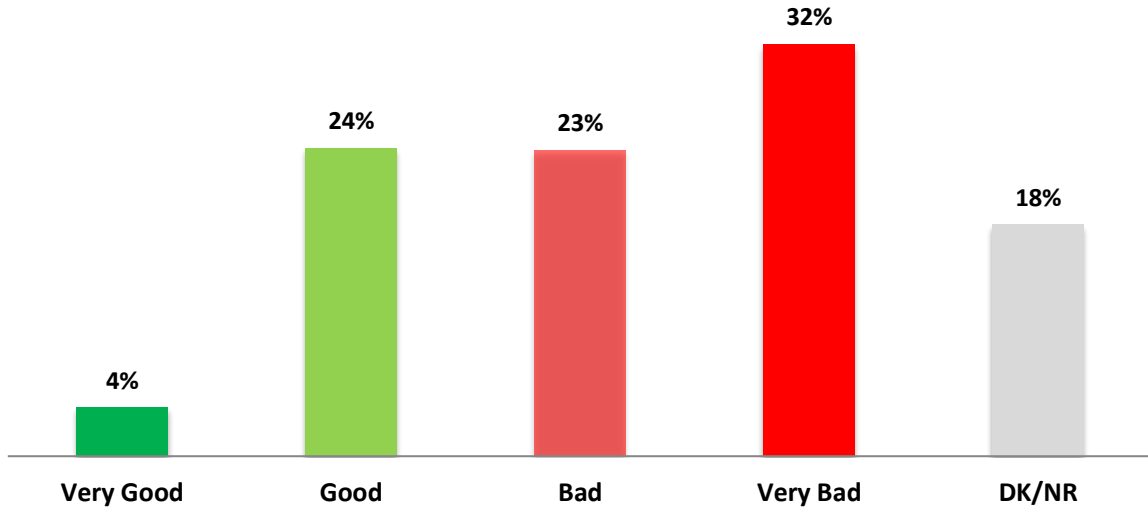

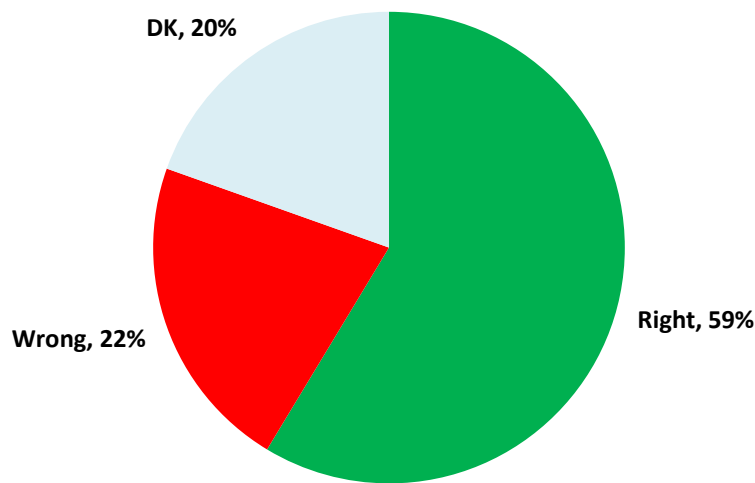

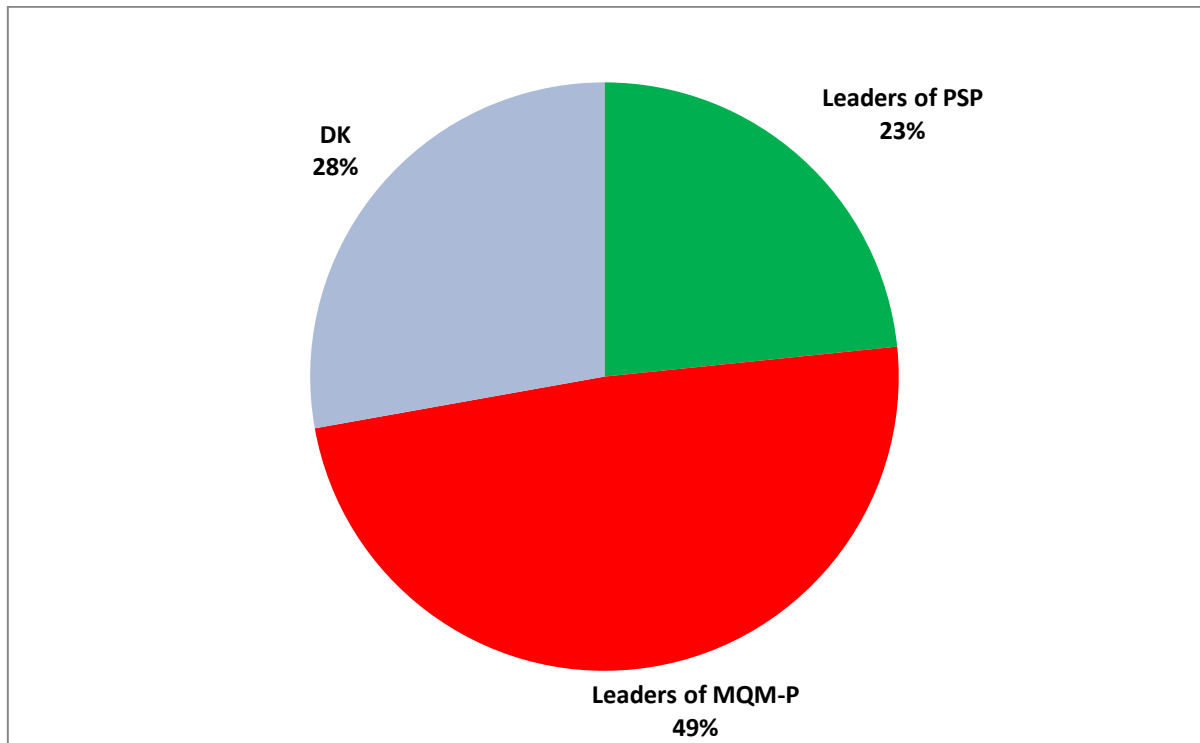

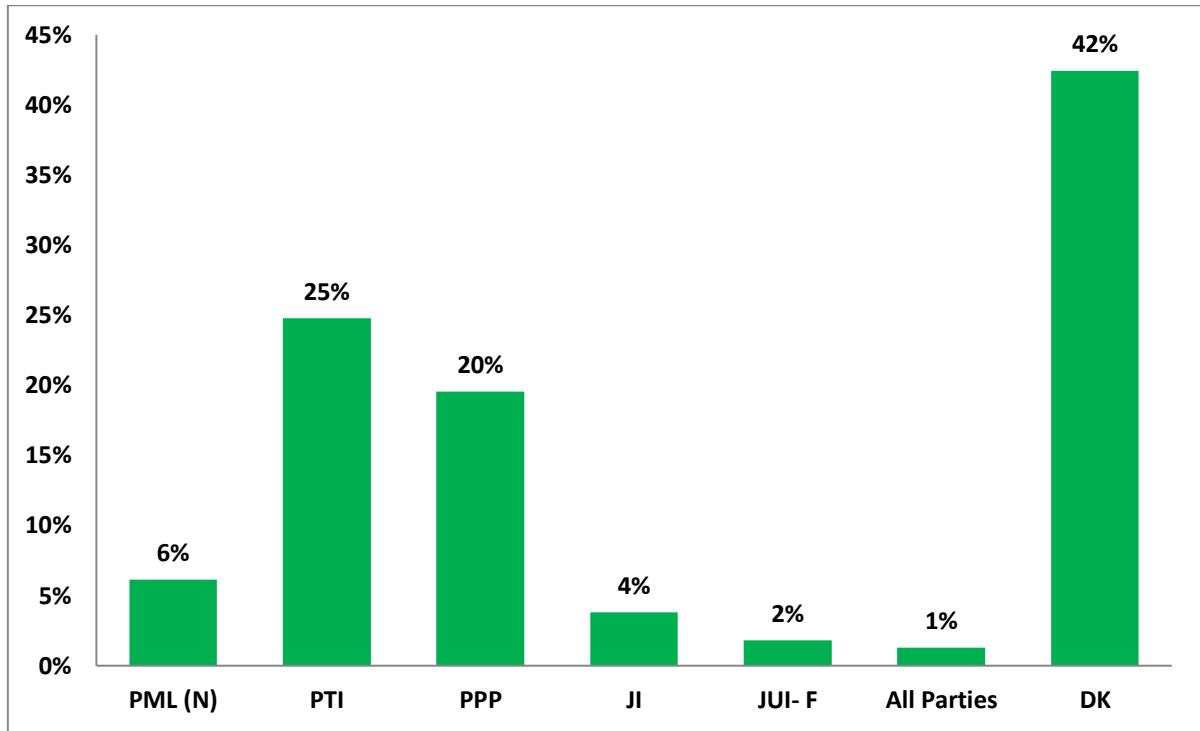

B- Sample Selection Procedure

This survey uses stratified random sampling. Following steps have been used to achieve this:

Stage 1: Stratification:

Stratification is principally at two levels:

- a. The **First** stratification is by PROVINCE, of which there are 4 in Pakistan.
- b. The **Second** stratification is by size of location. We stratify by 4 types of locations: Large/Metropolitan Cities (*there are 3*); Medium size (*those whom population is over 100,000 persons*); Towns (*those whom population is less than 100,000*) and Villages (*those declared as such in the Census*).

Stage 2: Selection of Communities:

Within each stratum communities are selected through a random process. In some cases we make replacements by communities of similar profile with a view to logistical and other considerations.

C- Fieldwork Procedure

● Briefing/Training of interviewers:

The Questionnaire Designed for the survey is briefed to the interviewers at Regional Centers across the Centre. The interviewers are instructed on measures such as:

1. Following Sampling/Quota Instructions Properly
2. Ethical Code of Conduct towards interviewers
3. Following skipping Instructions and other interview instructions on the Questionnaire
4. Maintaining Neutrality in asking Question



- **Mock Calls:**

After the briefing is completed all the field workers do the mock calls under the direct supervision of an executive or a fieldwork supervisor. This ensures that the field workers properly understand the instructions and they can handle various interviewing problems during the interview (*in the field*). After completion of mock calls, a debriefing session is arranged in which the problems faced by the interviewers during the mock interviews are discussed and solutions are suggested.

- **Initial Checking:**

After the training, the interviewers go into the field for actual interviewing. The first ten filled in questionnaires of every interviewer are thoroughly checked by their supervisor to ensure that the interviewer is performing well. In case the work of an interviewer is not acceptable he/she is disengaged from the survey.

- **Field Editor or Intake Edit:**

In normal routine at least 30-40 interviews of each interviewer are visually checked by the supervisor before passing them to Data Coding/Entry department. The problems or missing information identified during field edit are explained to the relevant interviewer and he/she is instructed to rectify them either through telephone and/or revisit the respondent for clarification and re-asking the missing questions.

- **Supervision & Back Checking:**

It is essential that the interviewers are properly supervised on the job and the work done by them is back checked. At least 20% back checking is done on work completed by each interviewer to ensure authenticity of data.

- **Data Coding/Editing:**

About 20% work of each coder is rechecked and verified by the concerned DC Supervisor/In-charge.



D- Data Entry and Verification

GP's Quality Manual contains a detailed check-list on the handling control, entry and other steps involved in the management of data.

Once the questionnaires are received from the field, they are checked and the responses of open-ended questions are coded with the help of a code list. A coding scheme/book/guide is prepared on the basis of these questionnaires.

After the coding of open-ended responses, data is entered into computers. GP uses the SPSS data entry program that has flexibility to implement validity checks and skipping rules etc. The SPSS data entry software also has flexibility to verify the entered data by using the double punch options. Gallup normally double punches for 20% of its entered data.

After completion of data entries and double punch, all data is cleaned by using a data-cleaning program written in SPSS which is customized for every project according to the survey/questionnaire needs. Data is thoroughly checked for an omission, displacements and other error resulting in inconsistencies with the coding scheme.
