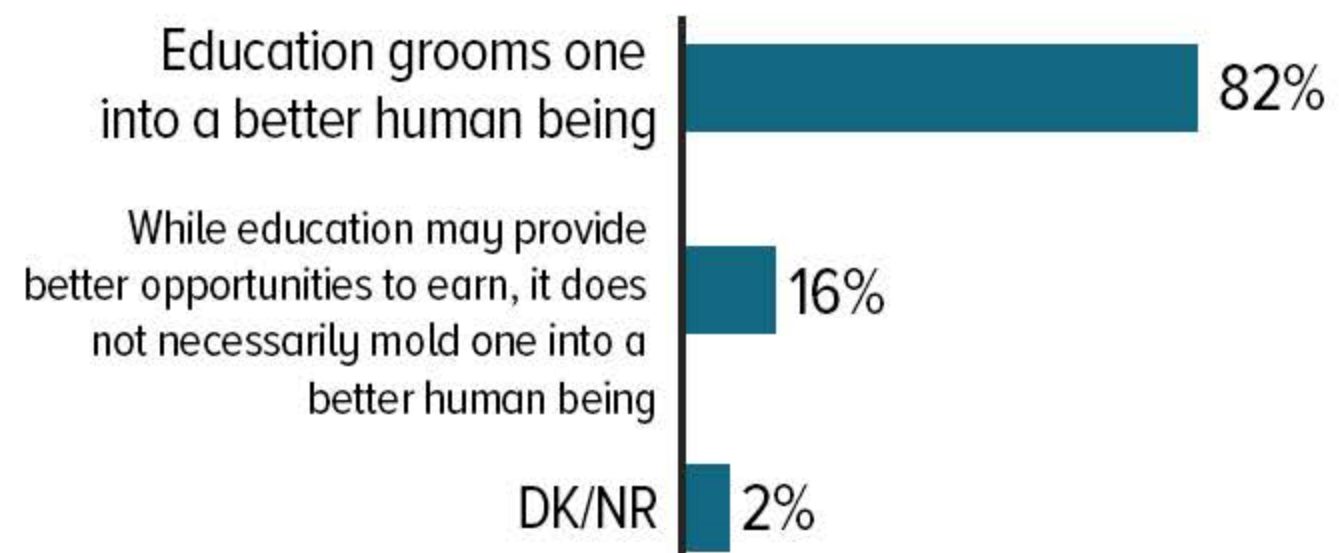

4 in 5 Pakistanis (82 %) agree to the claim that education grooms better human beings.

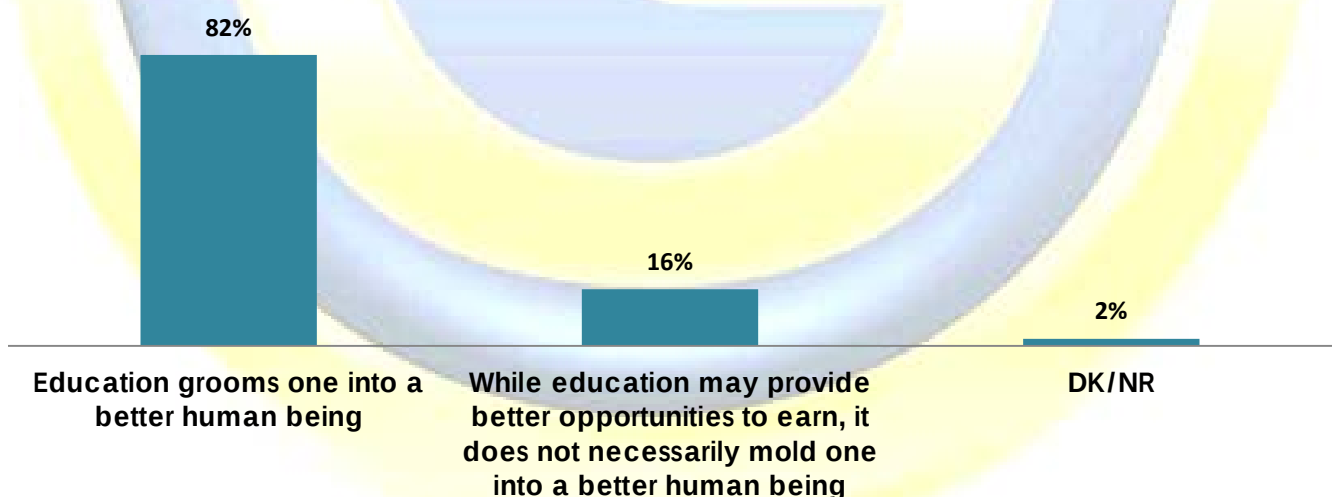

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 4 in 5 Pakistanis (82%) agree to the claim that education grooms better human beings.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Suppose that Wasim and Akhtar are two friends who are discussing the effects of education on one’s character. Wasim believes that education grooms one into a better human being. Akhtar believes that while education may provide better opportunities to earn it does not necessarily mold one into a better human being. Whose stance do you agree with, Wasim or Akhtar?” In response to this question, 82% said they agreed that education grooms one into a better human being, 16% said they agreed that while education may provide better opportunities to earn it does not necessarily mold one into a better human being, 2% did not know or wish to respond.

The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1710 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, January 28 –February 03, 2018. Error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 per cent at 95% confidence level.
