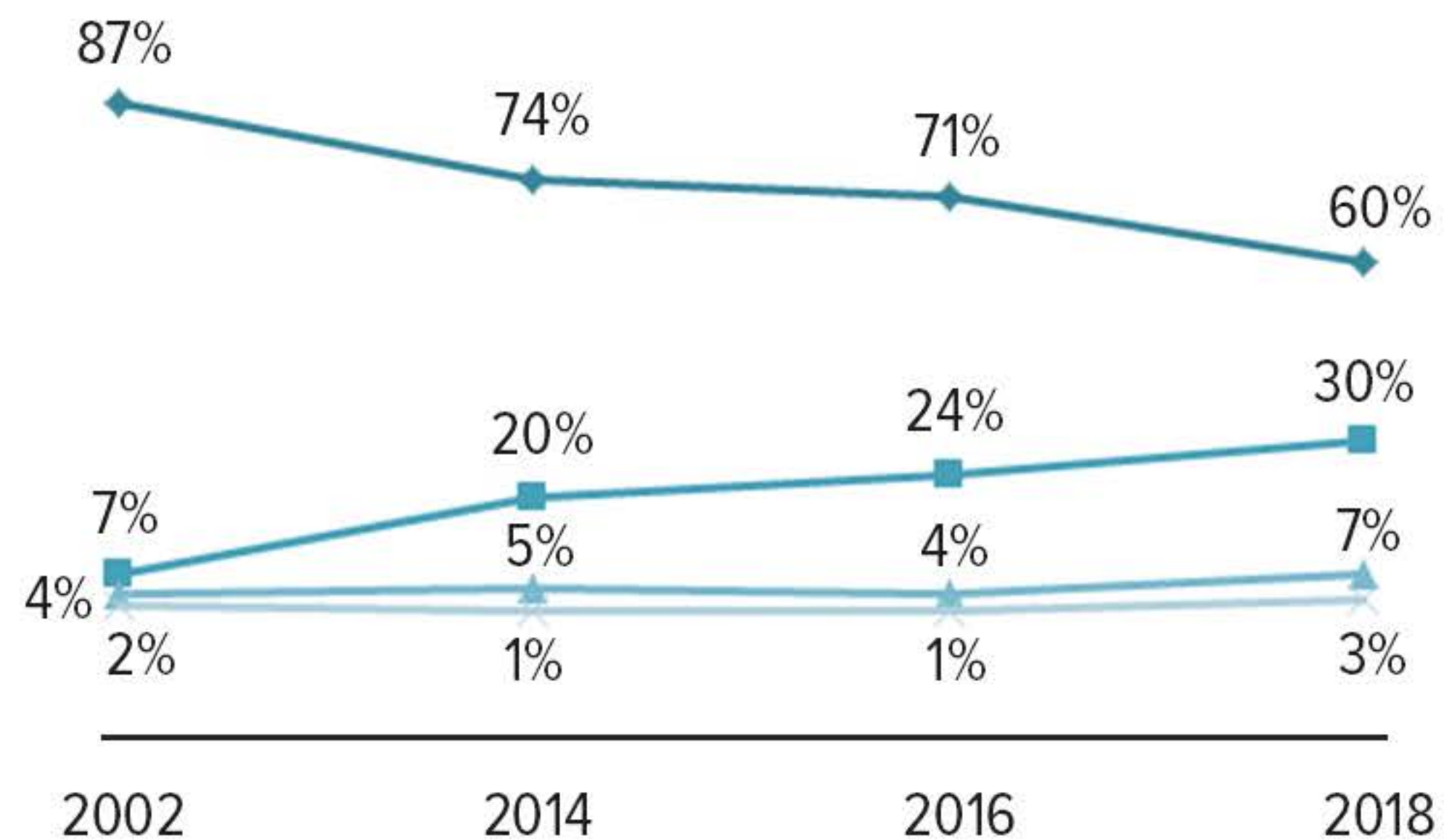

2002-2018: 27% DECLINE OBSERVED IN THE PROPORTION OF PAKISTANIS WHO OPINE IT IS VERY IMPORTANT FOR CHILDREN TO BE VACCINATED AGAINST POLIO.

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, over the past 16 years, there has been a 27% decline in the proportion of Pakistanis who opine it is very important for children to be vaccinated against polio.

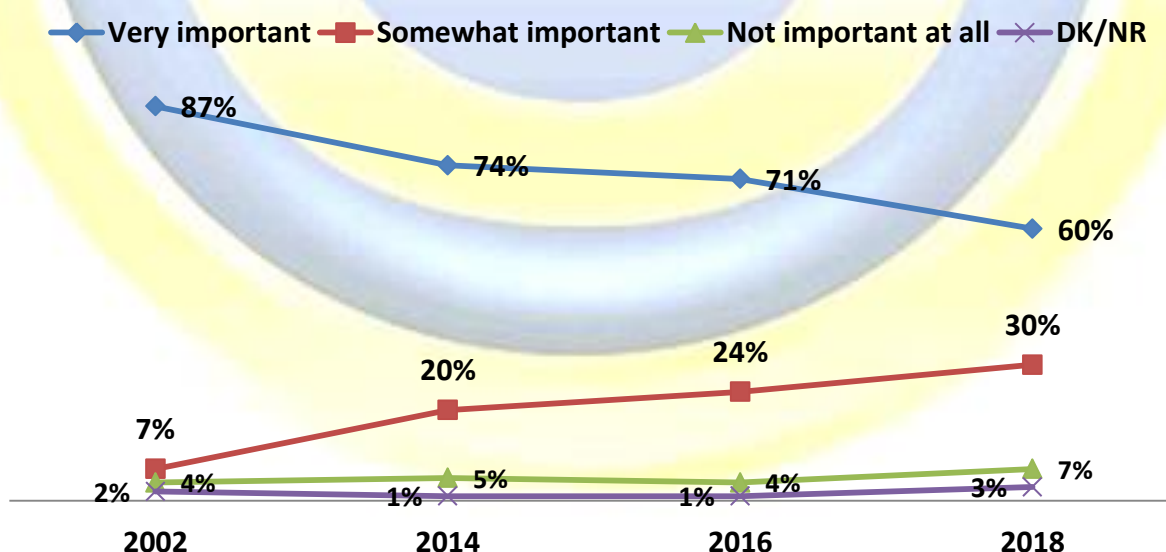
A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “In your opinion, how important is it for children to drink polio drops? Is it very important, somewhat important, or not important at all?” In response to this question, 60% said that it was very important, 30% said that it was somewhat important, while 7% said that it was not important at all. 3% did not know or did not wish to respond.

Supposing the adult population of Pakistan (age: 18+) to be approximately 100 million, around 7 million adults in Pakistan believe it is not important at all for children to drink polio drops.

Trend Analysis:

This question has also been asked in previous years. In 2002, 87% Pakistanis believed that it is very important for children to drink polio drops. But since then, the number has been reduced by more than 10% to 74% in 2014, 71% in 2016 and now 60% in 2018.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1672 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, April 23- April 30, 2018. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
