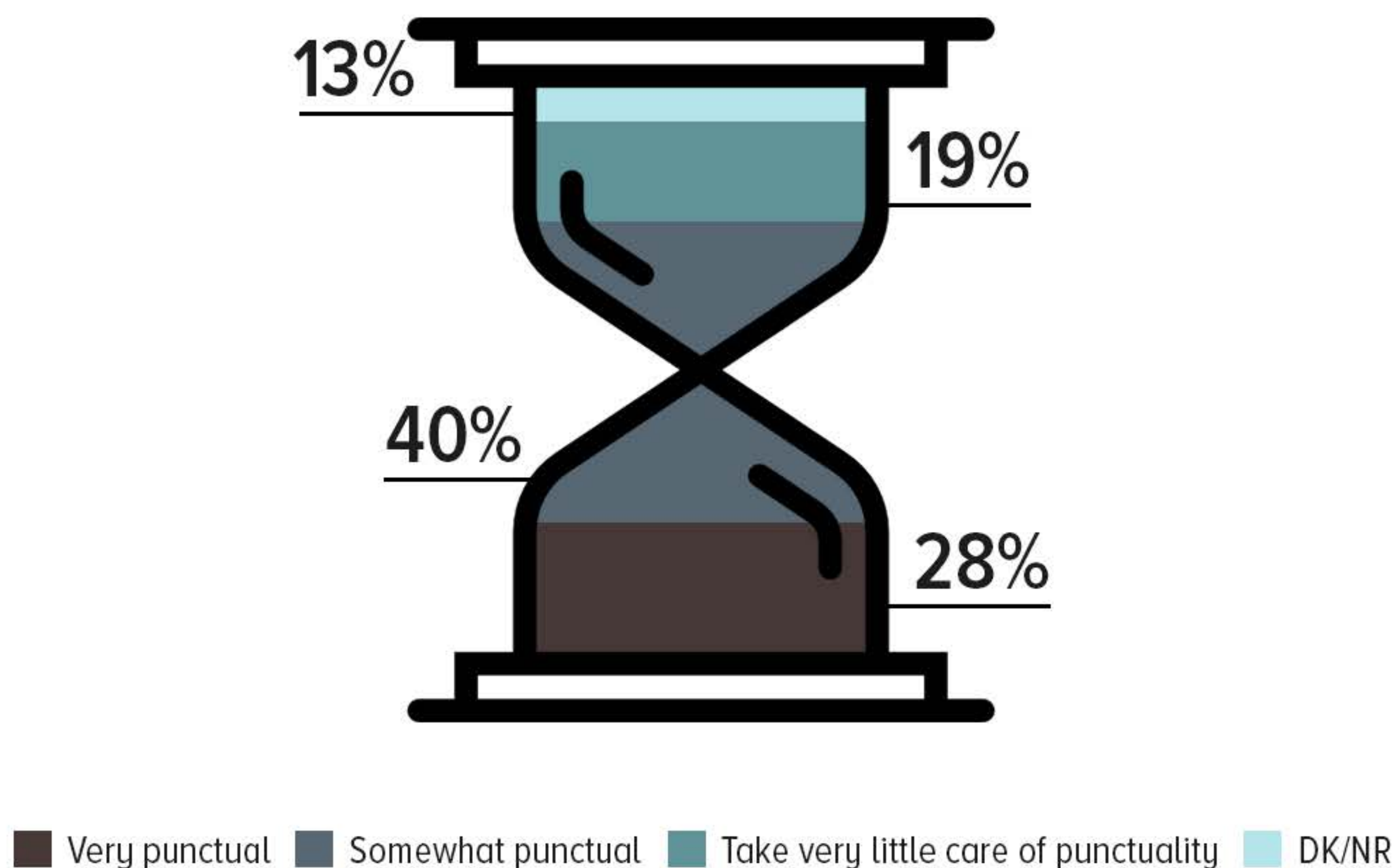

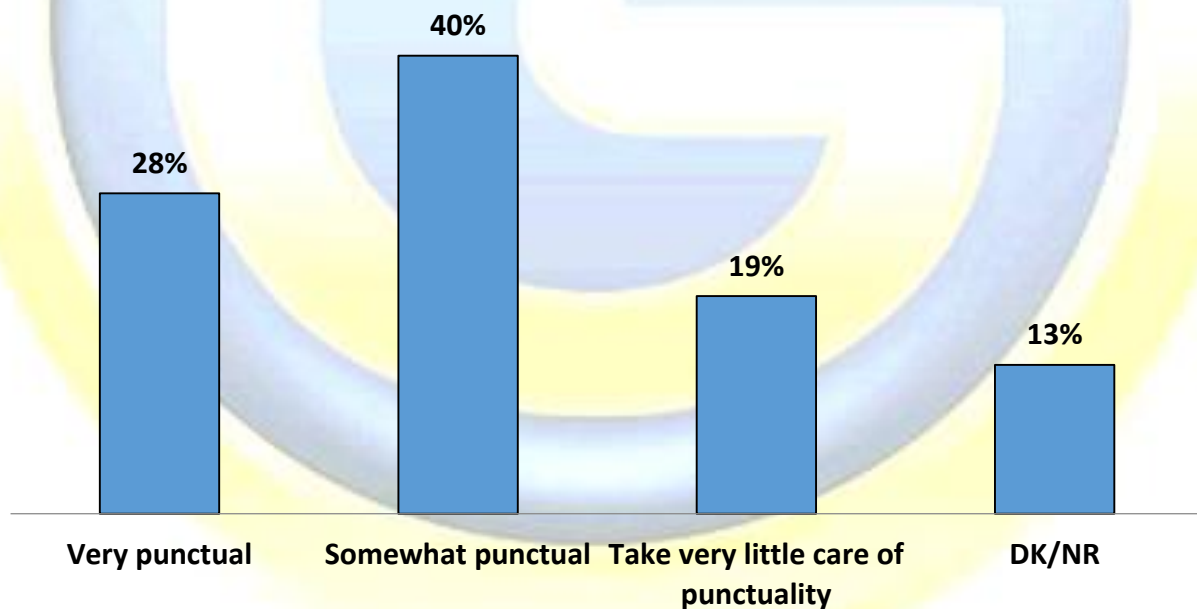
**28% Pakistanis say they are very punctual in their personal life; 40% say somewhat punctual.

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gillani Pakistan, 28% Pakistanis say they are very punctual in their personal life; 40% say somewhat punctual.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Some people take a lot of care in doing things on time, others are somewhat punctual, yet some others take very little care of punctuality. To what extent do you take care of punctuality in your personal life?” In response to this question, 28% respondents said they are very punctual in their personal life and 40% said somewhat punctual. On the other hand, 19% respondents said they take very little care of punctuality. 13% did not know or did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1607 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, April 30- May 07, 2018. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
