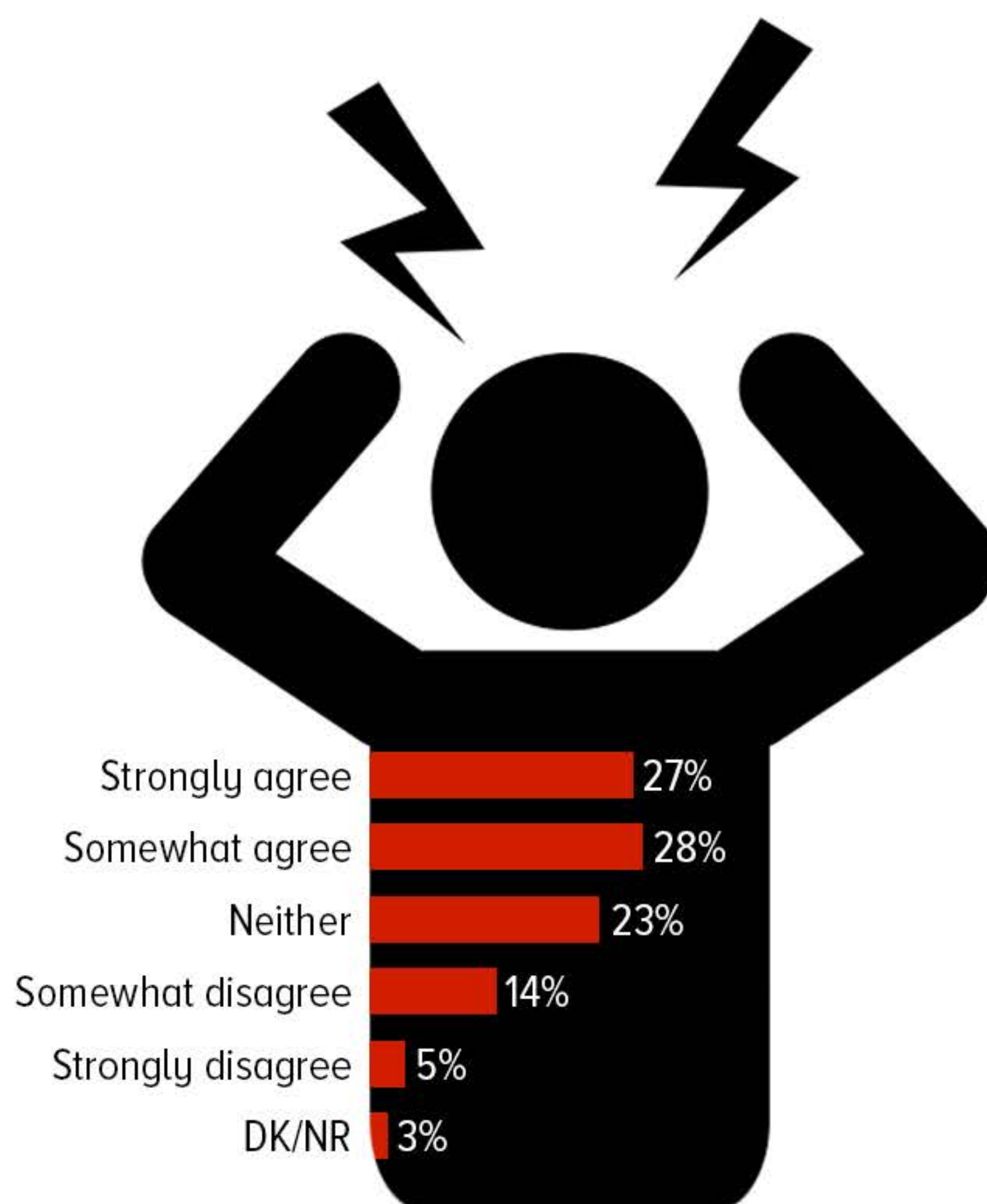

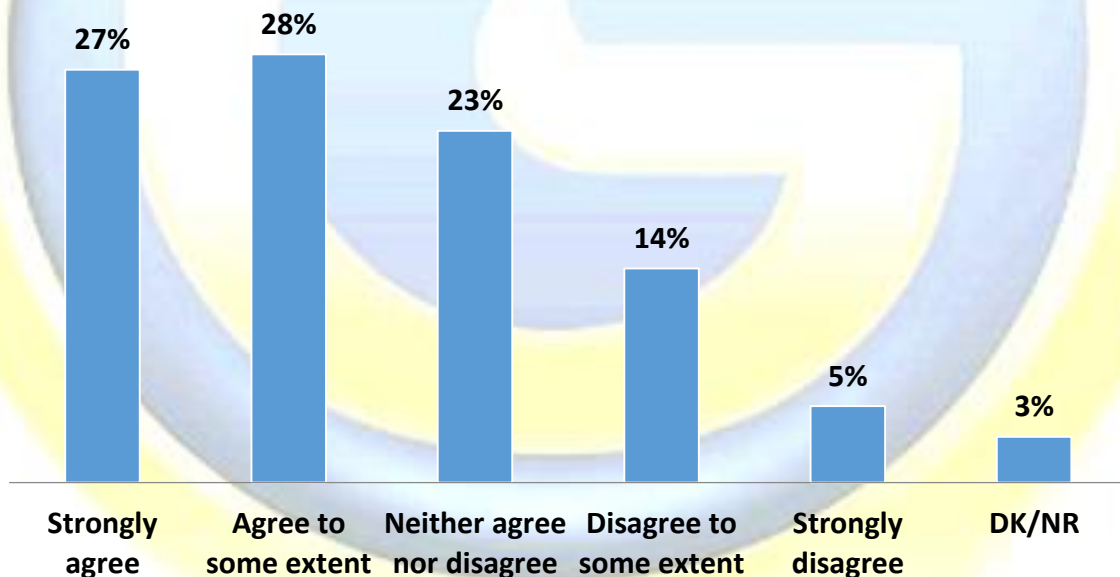
**Just over half Pakistanis (55%) believe that women tend to break more easily than men under stressful conditions.

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, just over half Pakistanis (55%) believe that women tend to break more easily than men under stressful conditions.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “To what extent do you agree or disagree with the following statement: *In stressful conditions, women give up more easily than men.*” In response to this question, 27% said strongly agree, 28% said somewhat agree, 23% said neither agree nor disagree, 14% said somewhat disagree and 5% said strongly disagree. 3% did not know or wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1607 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, April 30- May 7, 2018. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
