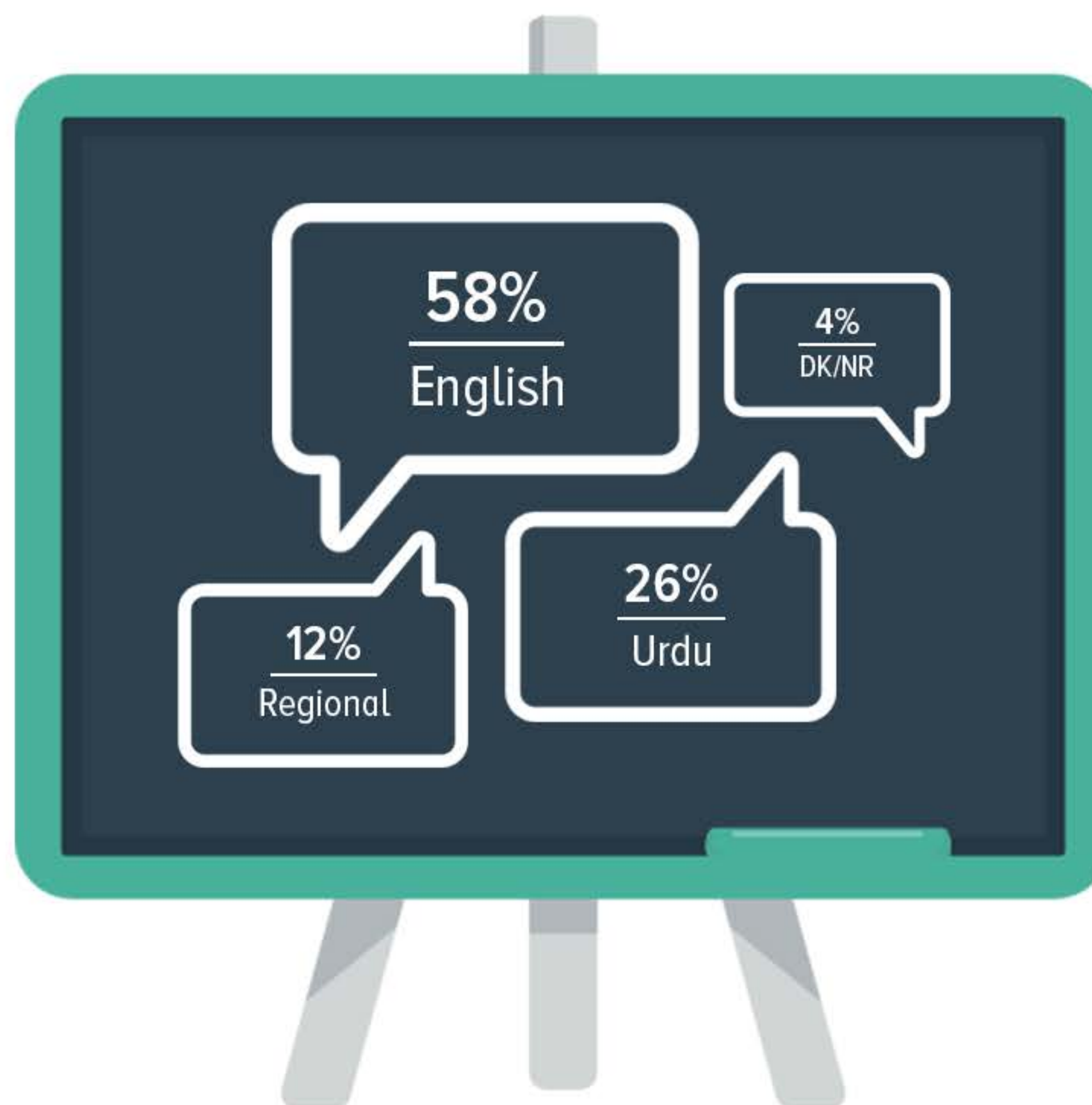

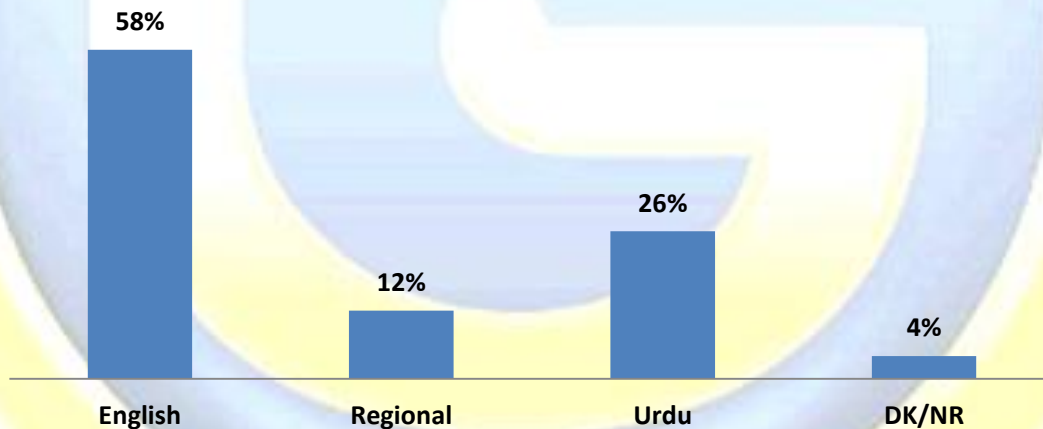
**58% Pakistanis opine that the medium of instruction for higher education in Pakistan should be English.

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 58% Pakistanis opine that the medium of instruction for higher education in Pakistan should be English.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “In your view what should be the medium of instruction for higher education in Pakistan?” In response to this question, 58% said English, 12% said Regional Language while 26% stated that Urdu should be the medium of instruction. 4% did not know or did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1715 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, May 7 – May 14, 2018. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
