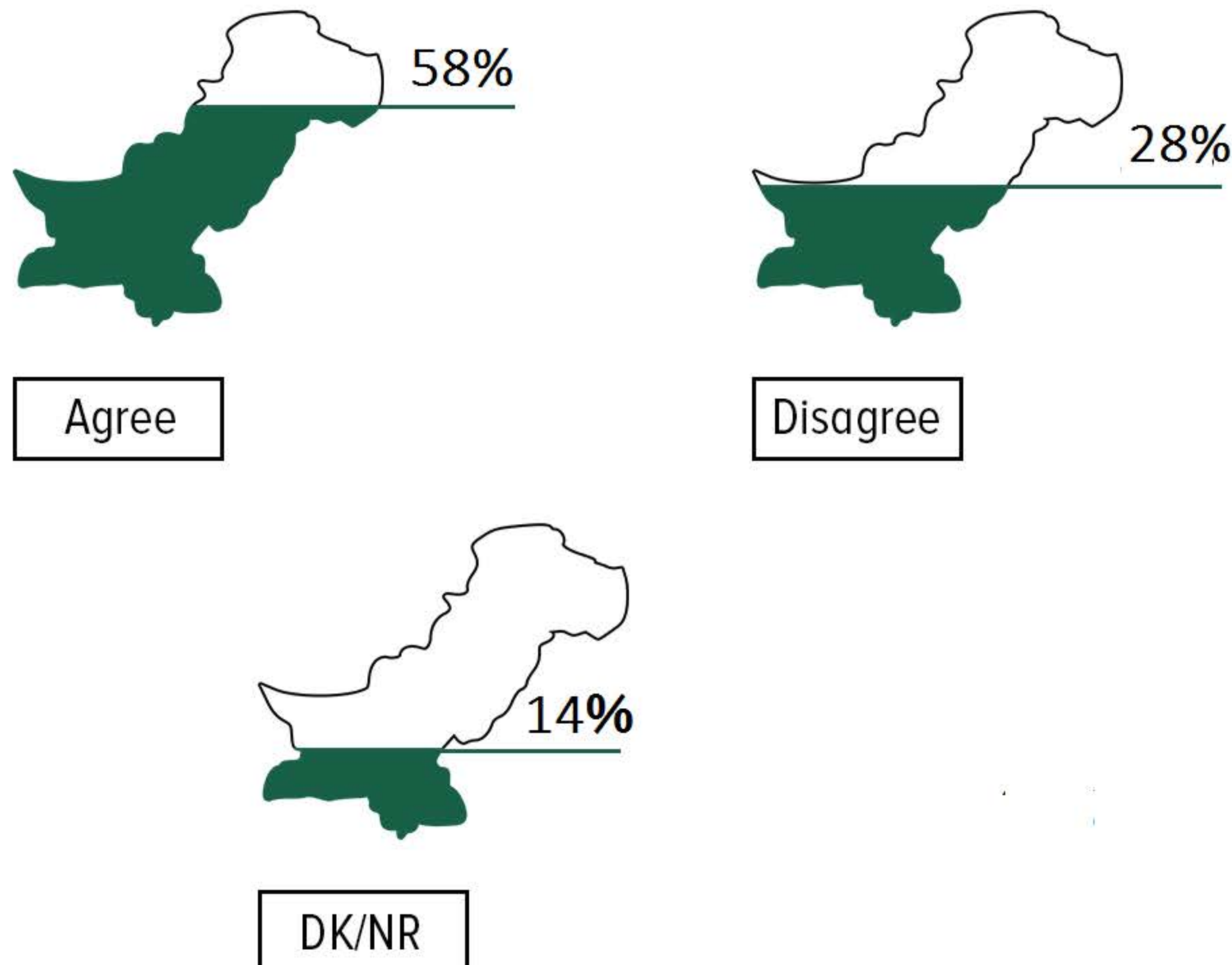

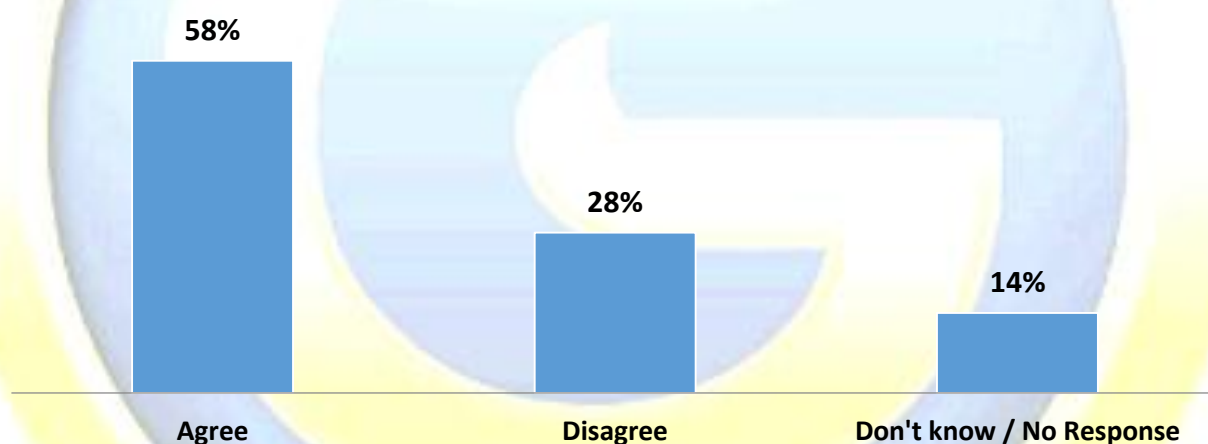
**58% Pakistanis believe that people who see only problems and nothing good in Pakistan, should be exiled from Pakistan.

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 58% Pakistanis believe that people who see only problems and nothing good in Pakistan, should be exiled from Pakistan.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked “To what extent do you agree with the following statement: [Some people can only see problems in Pakistan. Such people should be exiled from the country?].” In response to this question, 58% agreed with the statement, while 28% disagreed. 14% did not know or did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1506 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, June 11 – June 18, 2018. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
