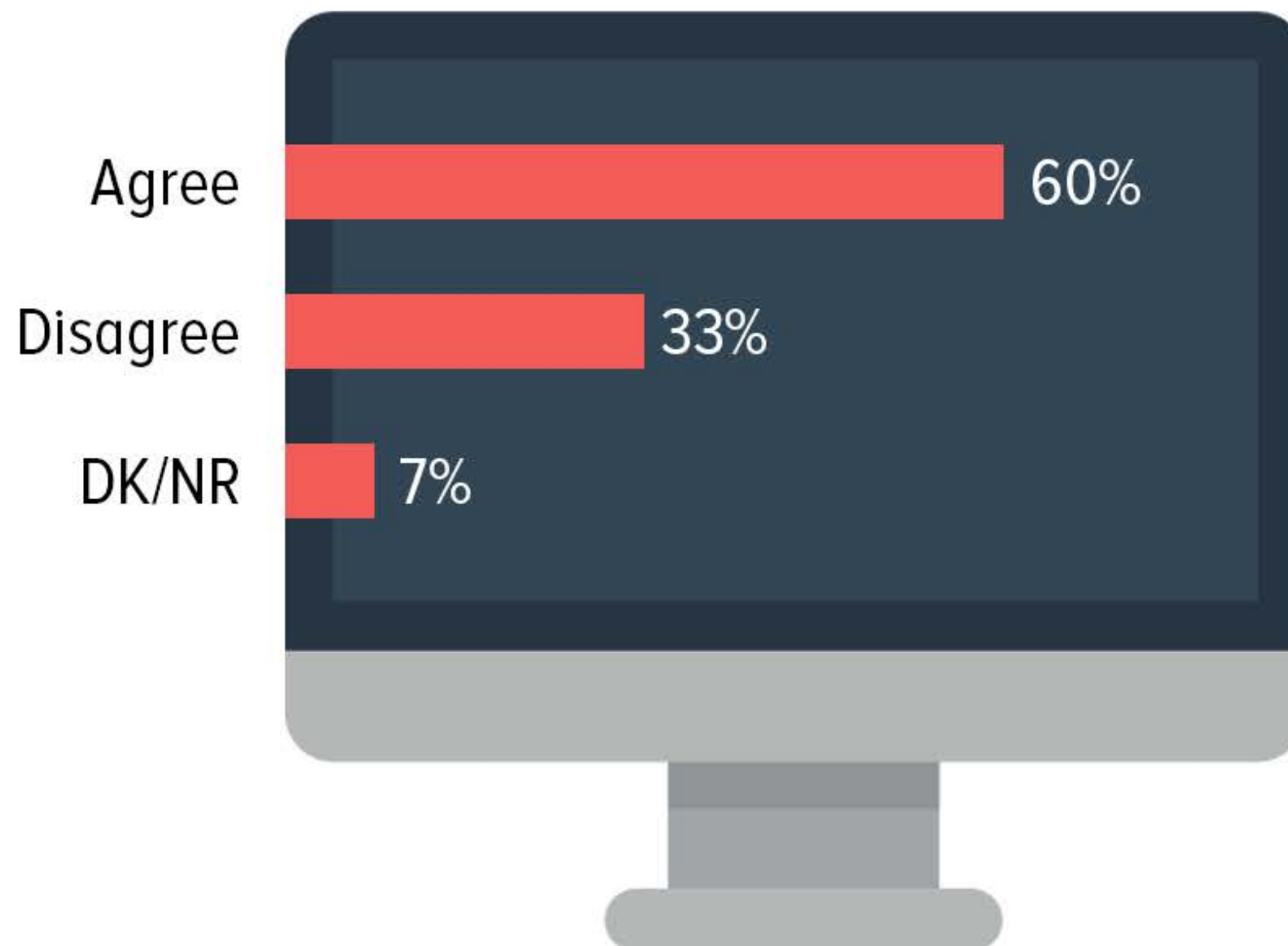

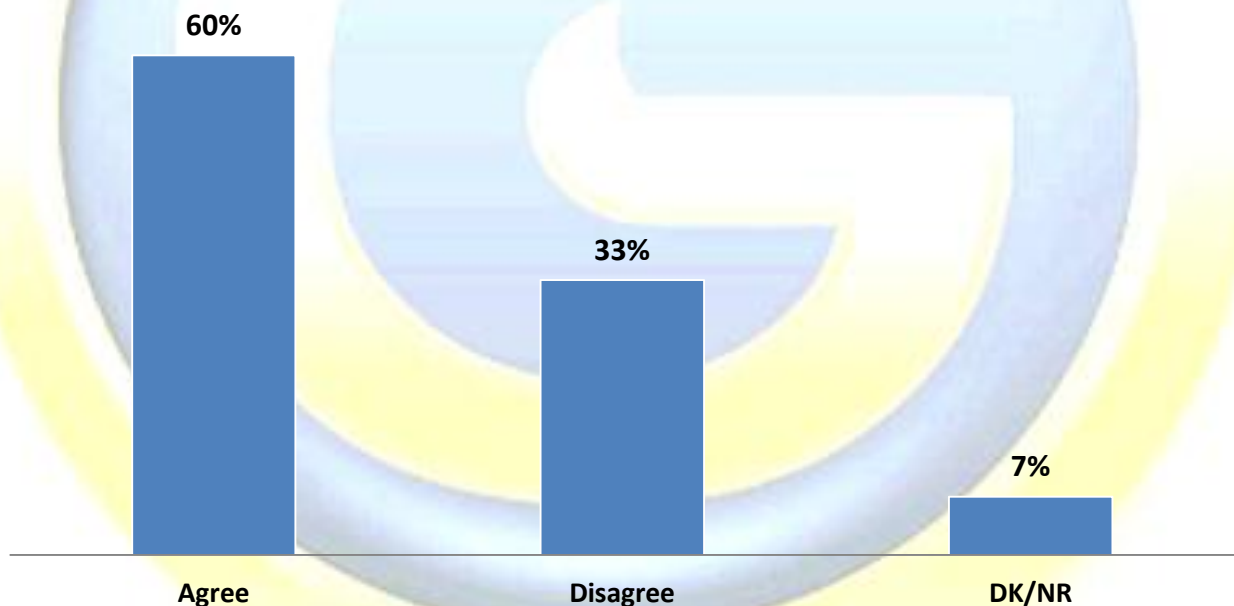
**60% Pakistanis believe that news channels are free from the influence of government in the country.

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 60% Pakistanis believe that news channels are free from the influence of the government in the country.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked “Please tell to what extend do you agree or disagree with the following statement: News channels in Pakistan are not influenced by the government?” In response to this, 60% said that they agreed while 33% disagreed with the statement. 7% did not know or did not wish to respond.

The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1546 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, July 02– July 09, 2018. Error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 per cent at 95% confidence level.
