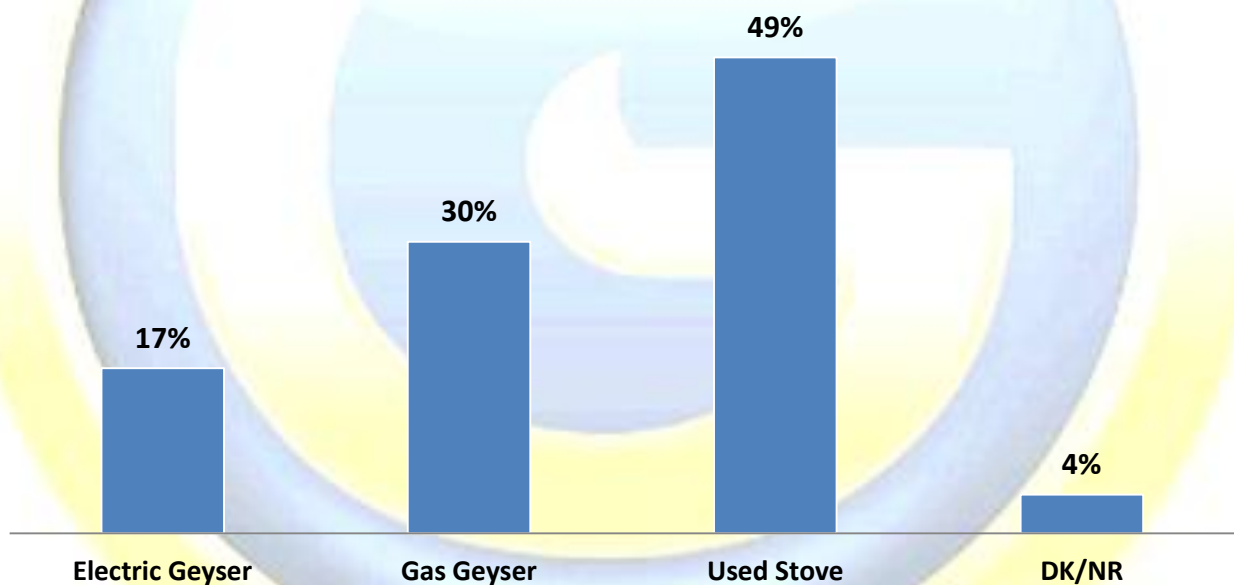
**Nearly half of the Pakistanis (49%) say they heat water on stove whenever hot water is needed; 30% use gas geyser.

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, nearly half of the Pakistanis say they heat water on stove whenever hot water is needed.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “In winters, or whenever hot water is needed, how is water heated in your home?” In response to this question, 17% said that they used electric geyser, 30% said they used a gas geyser, while 49% said they used a stove to heat water. 4% chose not to respond.

The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1567 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, July 09– July 16, 2018. Error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 per cent at 95% confidence level.
