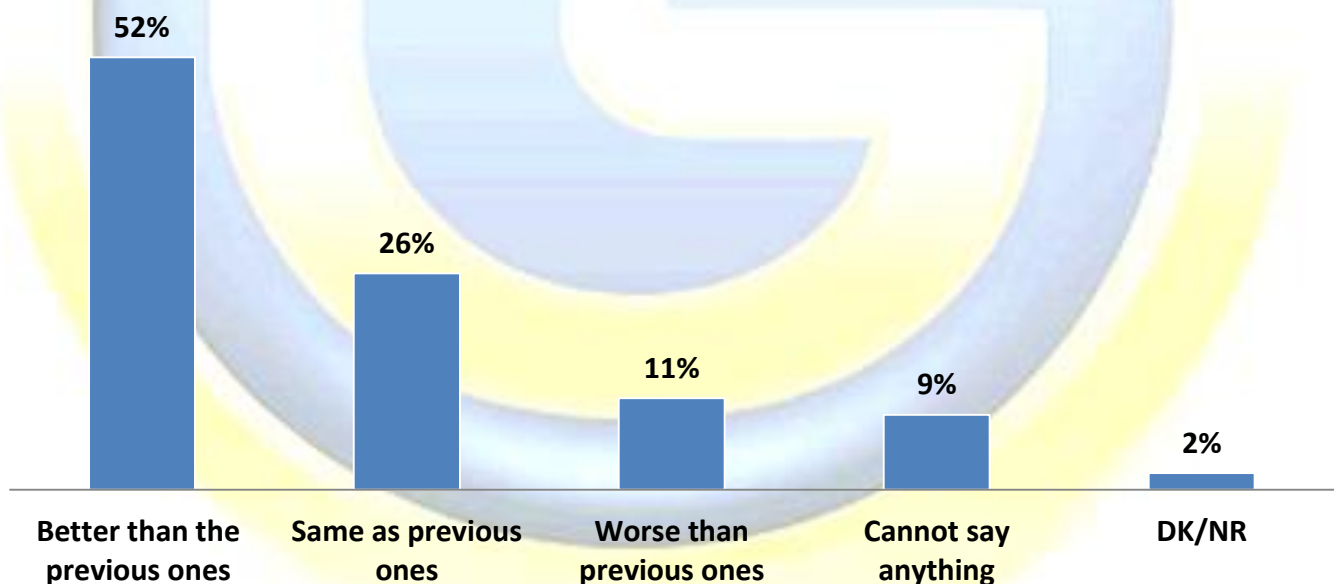
**1 in 2 (52%) Pakistanis believe that the newly elected members of National Assembly will be better than the previous ones.
(GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)**

Islamabad, September 26, 2018

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 1 in 2 (52%) Pakistanis believe that the newly elected members of National Assembly will be better than the previous ones.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked “The oath taking ceremony of newly elected members of the National Assembly has taken place. Some people think that the new members will be better than the previous ones while others think they will be the same. What do you think about it?” In response to this question, 52% said that they will be better, 26% said they will be the same, 11% said that they will be even worse than the previous ones, 9% said they cannot say anything while 2% did not respond to the question.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1468 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, August 20 – August 27, 2018. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level
