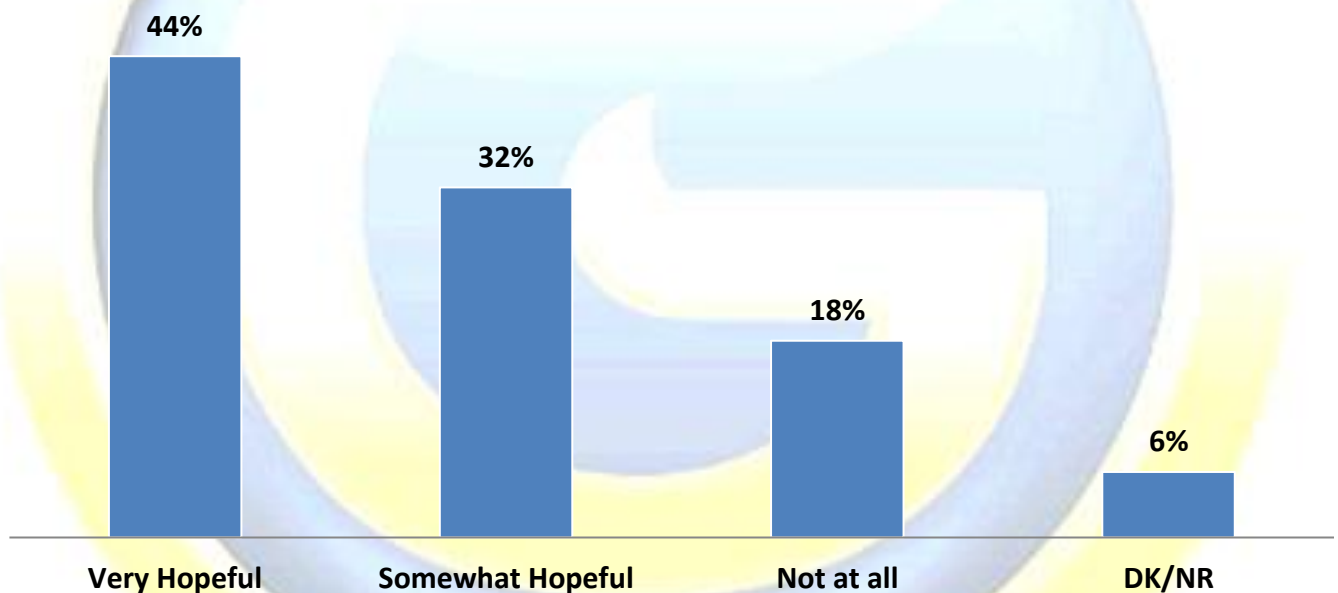
**44% Pakistanis are very hopeful that the new National Assembly will be successful in solving national issues.
(GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)**

Islamabad, September 27, 2018

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 44% Pakistanis are very hopeful that the new National Assembly will be successful in solving national issues.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked “How hopeful are you about the success of new assembly in solving national issues?” In response to this question, 44% said they are very hopeful, 32% said somewhat hopeful, 18% said that they are not hopeful at all, while 6% did not respond to the question.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1468 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, August 20 – August 27, 2018. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
