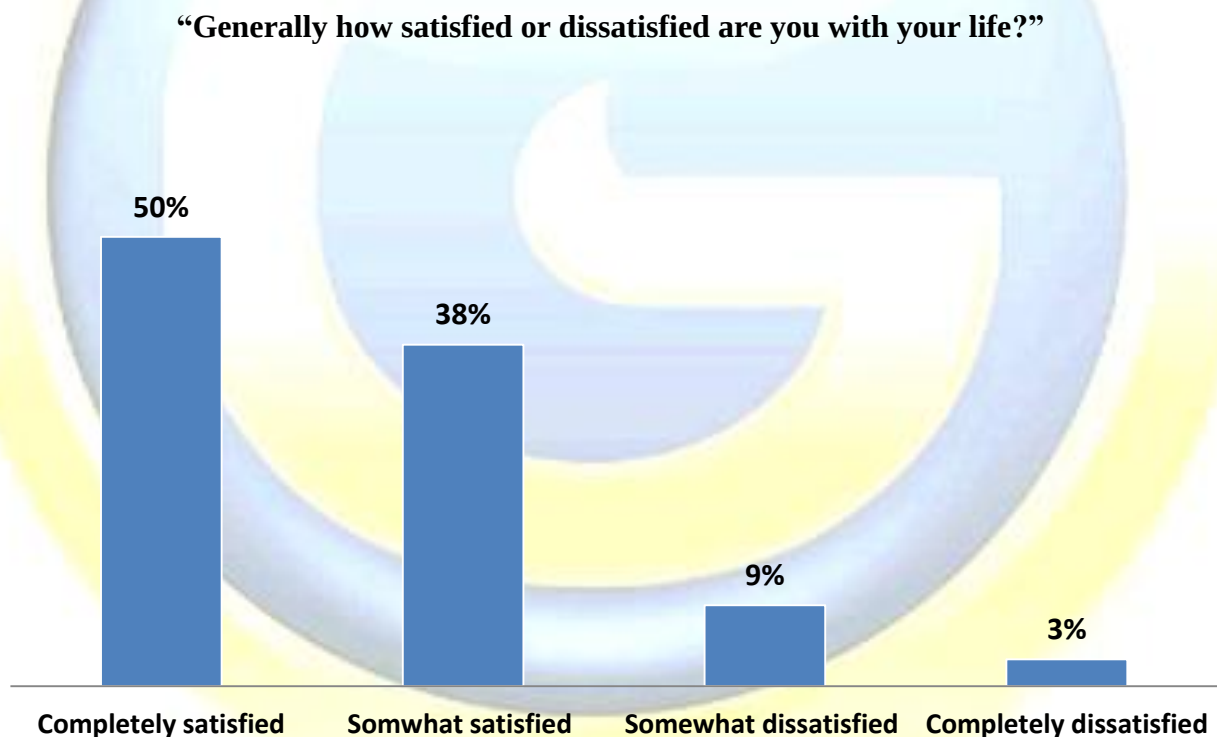

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, life satisfaction in Pakistan at 88%, including 1 in 2 Pakistanis who say they are completely satisfied with their life.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked “Generally how satisfied or dissatisfied are you with your life?” In response to this question, 50% said that they are completely satisfied, 38% said they are somewhat satisfied, 9% said they are somewhat dissatisfied while 3% said they are completely dissatisfied with their life.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1497 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, August 13 – August 20, 2018. Error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ per cent at 95% confidence level.
