USE OF PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Pakistan fares low in use of public transport compared to regional counterparts and global average: 1 in 5 Pakistanis say they use public transport, average commuting time per workday in Pakistan is 1 hour 27 minutes, 11% Pakistanis report using a bus / minibus.

According to survey conducted by Dalia Research and released in Pakistan by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, 20% Pakistanis use public transport, average commuting time per workday in Pakistan is 1 hour 27 minutes and 11% Pakistanis use a bus/ minibus to commute.

These interesting findings have emerged out of a 52 country research covering 75% of world population conducted by Dalia Research. The study comprised internationally of 43,034 respondents covering different ethnicities, regions, religions, age and gender.

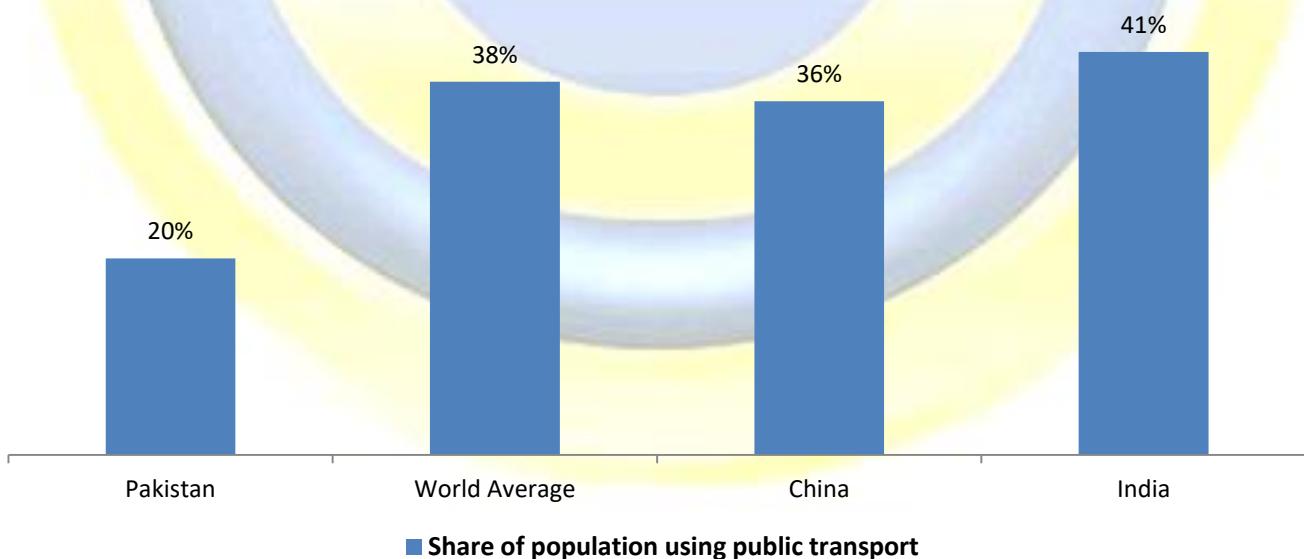
Use of Public Transport in Pakistan: Only 1 in 5 Pakistanis use public transport, China and India ahead of Pakistan.

1 in 5 Pakistanis use public transport.

Global result: 38% across the globe use public transport.

Comparing Pakistan's figure with the global average figure, 18% less Pakistanis use public transport compared to the global average of 38%.

Regional Results: In China, 36% use public transport; the figure is 41% for India.

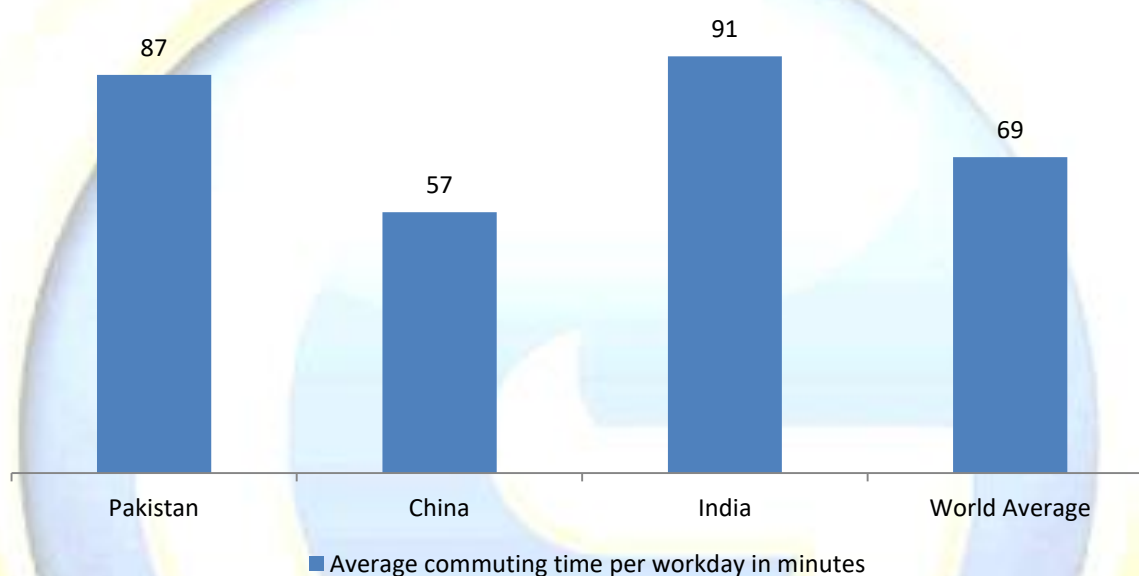
Average Commuting Time per Workday in Pakistan: On Pakistan has a higher average commuting time per workday compared to the global average; average commuting time per workday significantly lower in China compared to Pakistan and India.

On average, commuting time per workday in Pakistan is 1 hour 27 minutes.

Global result: Globally, the average commuting time per workday is 1 hour 9 minutes.

Comparing Pakistan's figure with the global average figure, the average commuting time per workday is 18 minutes more than the global average.

Regional Results: In China, average commuting time per workday is 57 minutes. In India on average, commuting time per workday is 1 hour 31 minutes.

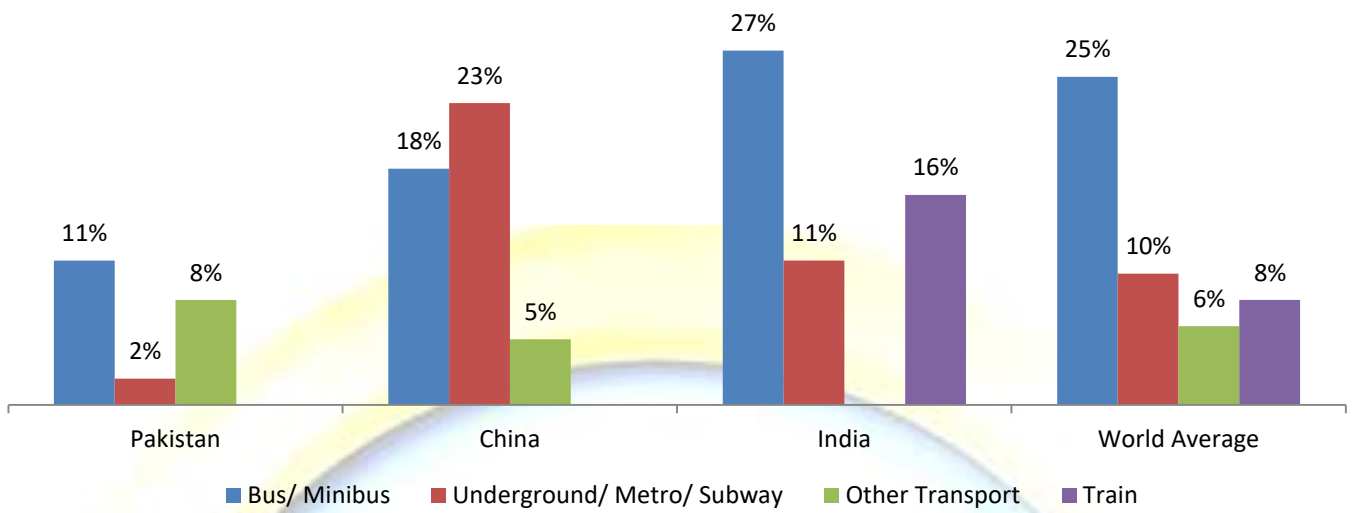
Most Popular Transport Options: Use of bus/ minibus and underground/ metro/ subway lower in Pakistan. Underground / metro/ subway most popular transportation in China (23%), bus / minibus in India (27%).

In Pakistan, 11% of the population uses bus/ minibus. Use of underground/ metro /subway is very low (2%). 8% respondents report using other transport options.

Global result: Globally, 25% respondents use a bus / minibus, 10% use underground/ metro/ subway, 8% use train and 6% say they use other transport options.

Comparing Pakistan's figure with the global average figure, 14% less Pakistanis use bus/ minibus, 8% more across the globe use underground / metro / subway and 2% more Pakistanis use other transportation modes.

Regional Results: In China, 18% respondents use a bus / minibus, 23% use underground / metro/ subway, and 5% say they use other transport options. In India, 27% respondents use a bus/ minibus, 11% use underground/ metro/ subway and 16% say they use train.
