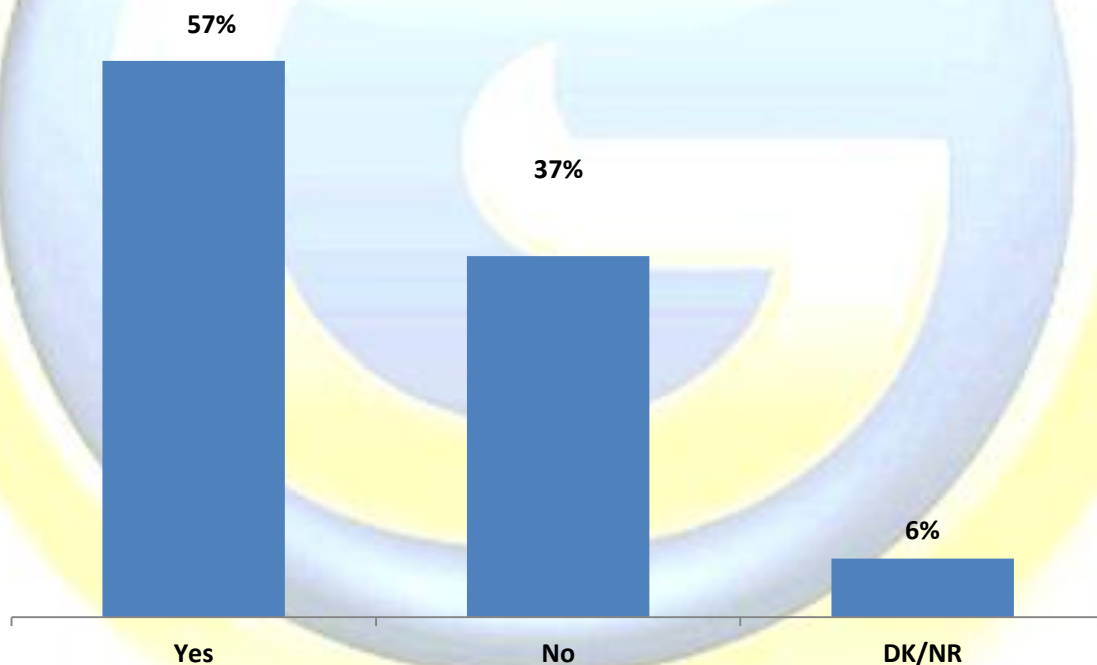

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, nearly 6 in 10 (57%) urban Pakistanis have heard about car-hailing mobile apps such as Careem and Uber.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Have you heard about car-hailing applications such as Careem and Uber?” Of the urban respondents, 57% replied yes, 37% said no, while 6% did not know or did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 960 men and women in rural and urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during November 19 – November 26, 2018. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
