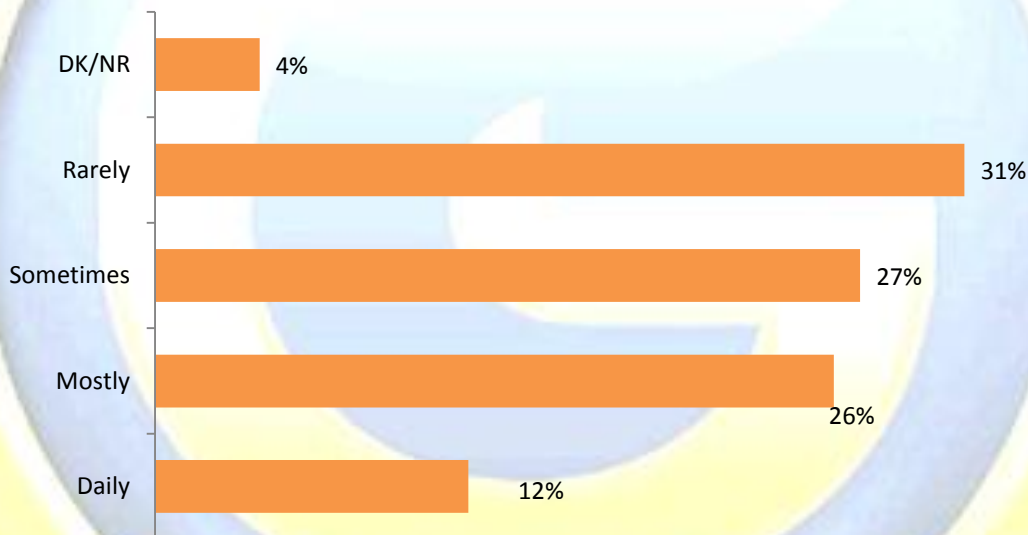

Travel**Public transport: Nearly 4 in 10 (38%) urban Pakistanis report using public transport frequently (daily or mostly).
(GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)**

Islamabad, January 2, 2019

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup Pakistan, nearly 4 in 10 (38%) urban Pakistanis report using public transport frequently (daily or mostly).

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across urban areas of the four provinces was asked, “How often do you use public transport, such as a public bus, rickshaw, taxi or metrobus?” In response to this question, 12% said daily, 26% said mostly, 27% said sometimes, 31% said rarely, while 4% did not know or did not wish to respond.

Bilal Gilani, Executive Director at Gallup Pakistan, adds “This poll shows how crucial public transport is for an average urban dweller. Despite this fact, public transport has been a neglected government priority, which has led to severe shortages and quality problems with respect to access to public transport. The findings also underscore the need to enhance cheap and frequent availability of Metro Bus type mass transit projects.”

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 960 men and women in urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during November 19 – November 26, 2018. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level.
