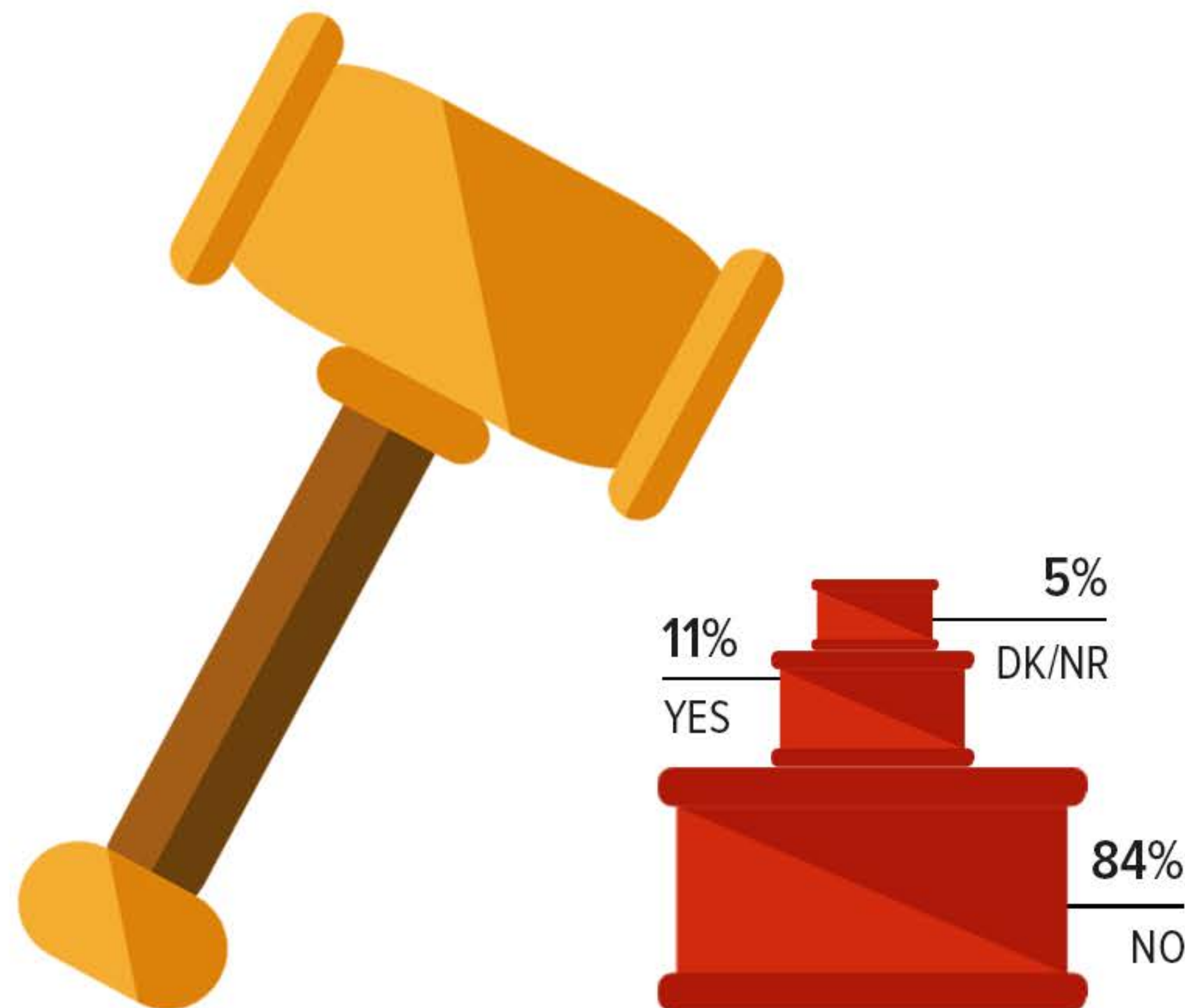

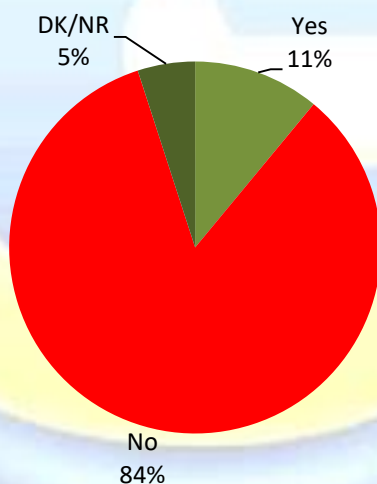

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, at 84%, the vast majority of Pakistanis report that neither they themselves, nor any of their close relatives, have ever visited the court for any reason.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “Please tell whether you or any of your close family members (sister, brother, spouse, uncles, etc.) has ever been to the court for any reason?” In response to this question, 11% said yes, 84% said no, while 5% did not know or did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,443 men and women in urban areas of all four provinces of the country, during 5 November – 12 November, 2018. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
