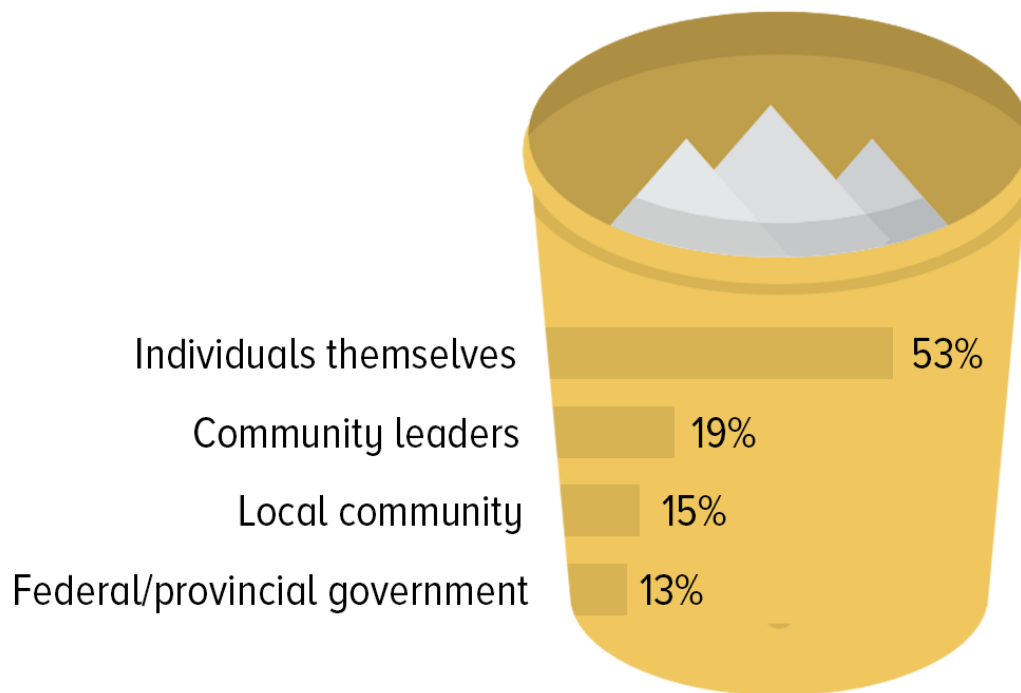

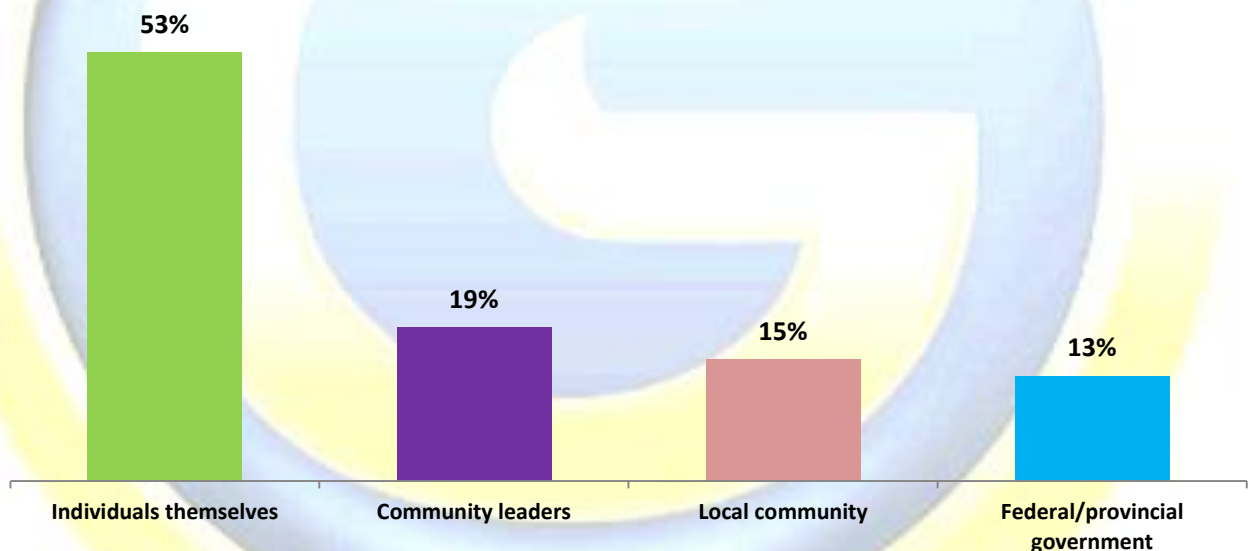

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, more than half Pakistanis (53%) believe that individuals/households themselves should be responsible for keeping neighborhoods clean; only 13% think it is the government's responsibility.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, "Who do you think should be responsible for keeping neighborhoods clean?" In response, 53% said individuals themselves, 19% said community leaders, 15% said the local community, and 13% said the federal/provincial government.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,128 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during March 2-March 5, 2019. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level.
