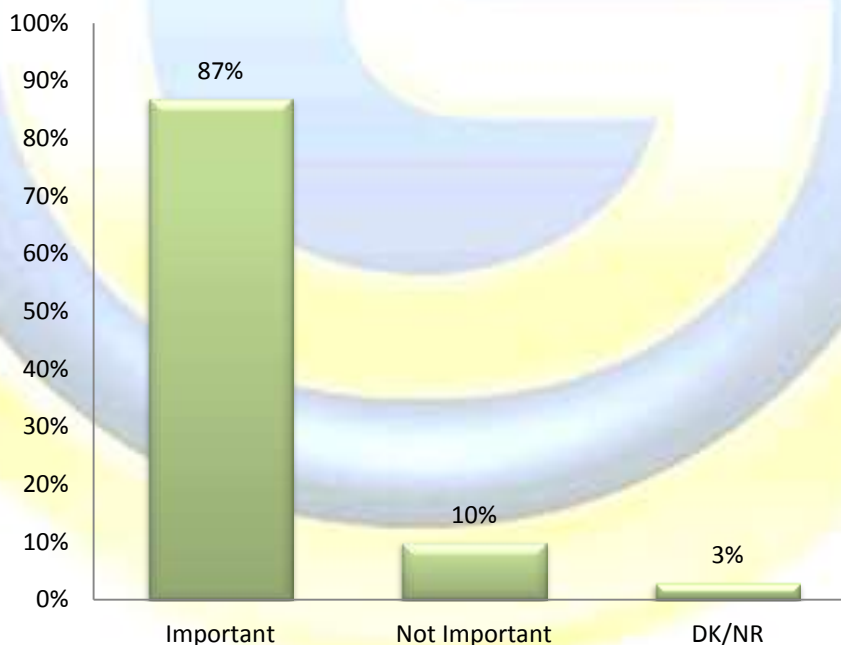

Travel****Overwhelmingly high numbers of Pakistani adults (87%) think it is important for ministers and senior officers to travel in the city's buses with the public a minimum of one time in every month (GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)**

Islamabad, August 29, 2019

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, overwhelmingly high numbers of Pakistani adults (87%) think it is important for ministers and senior officers to travel in the city's buses with the public a minimum of one time in every month.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, "Please tell if you think that it is important or not suitable for ministers and senior officers to travel in the city's buses with the public a minimum of one time in every month?" In response, 87% believed that this is an important step to take whereas 6% Pakistanis felt that it is not an important step to take. 4% Pakistanis thought that it is not suitable while another 3% said they did not know/did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,372 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 02 – August 09, 2019. The error margin is estimated to be approximately ± 2 -3 percent at the 95% confidence level.
