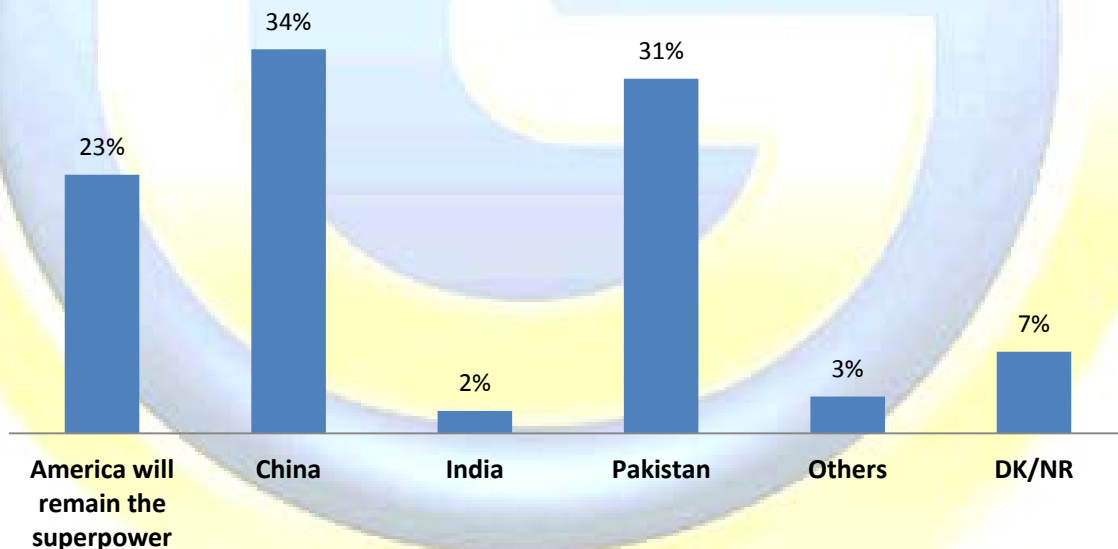
One third Pakistanis (34%) believe that China will become the next global superpower. (GALLUP & GILANI PAKISTAN POLL)

Islamabad, September 18, 2019

According to a Gilani Research Foundation Survey carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, one third Pakistanis (34%) believe that China will become the next global superpower.

A nationally representative sample of men and women from across the four provinces was asked, “In your opinion, which country will be the next superpower of the world? (Choose from the given options: America, China, India, Pakistan or others)” In response, 34% Pakistanis said that China will become the next superpower, 31% said Pakistan will become the next superpower, 23% said America will remain the global superpower, 2% said India will become a superpower, 3% said some other country will become the next superpower, and the remaining 7% did not know/ did not wish to respond.

The study was released by Gilani Research Foundation and carried out by Gallup & Gilani Pakistan, the Pakistani affiliate of Gallup International. The recent survey was carried out among a sample of 1,372 men and women in urban and rural areas of all four provinces of the country, during August 02 – August 09, 2019. The error margin is estimated to be approximately $\pm 2-3$ percent at the 95% confidence level.
